Rubicon Label releases Dani Howard's debut symphonic album on Friday 22 March. Recorded by the Royal Liverpool Philharmonic Orchestra conducted by Pablo Urbina and Michael Seal, the album includes the RPS award-winning Trombone Concerto for Peter Moore, which The Times described as "an instant classic". The audio for the disc is available here.

The disc opens with Argentum (Silver), a light, playful work which was commissioned for Classic FM's silver anniversary in 2017 by the RLPO. performance led to two further commissions from the RLPO - Coalescence and then the Trombone Concerto. Coalescence explores the concept of humans versus nature, inspired by a tree in central London where the meter-wide trunk had grown in and around a metal railing. The most recent work on the album is *Ellipsis* written for the RPO and Vasily Petrenko, which he premiered at his opening concert as Music Director.

Dani Howard describes the Trombone Concerto:

"In the first movement, the humming rhythms of day-to-day life (embodied in the solo trombone's instruction to play as if totally oblivious to the surroundings) are displaced by a gradual Realisation. This seed of an idea is turned over and over in the 2<sup>nd</sup> movements *Ruminations* before the ecstatic finale *Illumination* in which the soloist's resolve is borne out in a burst of fireworks. I feel so fortunate to have been given all these opportunities to write for orchestra and that is why I would like to dedicate this album to Sandra Parr and Andrew Cornall from the RLPO for taking a chance on me so early in my career. Their support has been a catalyst for so many of the wonderful opportunities that have since come my way".

Peter Moore will give the US premiere of Howard's Trombone Concerto will be given its US premiere with The Orchestra Now conducted by Chloé van Soeterstède at the Frederick P. Rose Hall in New York on Sunday 19 May.

On Thursday 18 April, Dame Evelyn Glennie and BBC National Orchestra of Wales will perform the world premiere of Howard's Percussion Concerto at BBC Hoddinott Hall, Cardiff. The award-winning percussionist is President of Help Musicians – she is only the third person to hold the position after Edward Elgar and Peter Maxwell-Davies.

All in all, 2024 is a thrilling year for Dani Howard, who has just been announced as Artist in Residence with the National Youth Orchestra (NYO) following the critically-acclaimed premiere of Ascent at the Barbican in January 2024. The NYO will be announcing a further commission from Howard this summer.

#### **Dani Howard**



Dani Howard is a British composer and orchestrator who is quickly gaining international recognition with regular performances across Europe, the US and Asia. Winner of a Royal Philharmonic Society Award for her Trombone Concerto, Howard has had works commissioned and performed by over forty orchestras worldwide, including the London Symphony Orchestra, Royal Philharmonic Orchestra, City of Birmingham Symphony Orchestra, and five BBC orchestras.

Howard's Trombone Concerto was premiered in 2021 by Royal Liverpool Philharmonic Orchestra and soloist Peter Moore. Dubbed "an instant classic... lush... riveting..." (Richard Morrison, *The Times*), the work received a Royal Philharmonic Society Award in the Large-Scale

Composition category. The concerto was nominated in the Classical Music category at the 2022 South Bank Sky Arts Awards, where Howard was also nominated for The Times Breakthrough Artist of the Year Award. The concerto has since received performances with London Symphony Orchestra, Ulster Orchestra and Gävle Symfoniorkester among others; the US premiere will take place in



May 2024 with Peter Moore, The Orchestra NOW and conductor Chloé van Soeterstède.
