Annapolis, MD resident, Peter Burrows, is a pretty good player, but he makes jokes about his abilities when it comes to the caliber of the players in this year's 13th annual 2017 American 14.1 Straight Pool Championship being held at Diamond Billiards, just outside of Richmond, VA on Oct. 17-21, 2017.

Peter, who is the Tournament Chairman, said that three dozen world class players from around the globe, USA, ASIA, EUROPE will come to the Richmond area for five days to compete in one of the top 14.1 tournaments in the world. Players include recent World 14.1 Champions: Thorsten Hohmann (2015, 2013, 2011, 2006), Darren Appleton (2014), Niels Feijen (2008) and John Schmidt (2012) & legend Bob Hunter (1990) along with Hall of fame players Mika Immonen, Rodney Morris, Karen Corr & Johnny Archer and European greats David Alcaide & Ralf Souquet along with half a dozen of Asia's finest layers. The field also includes the top 14.1 players in the USA: Jayson Shaw, Shaun Wilkie, Bob Maidhof, Brandon Shuff, Danny Barouty plus a dozen of the nation's finest Straight Pool players in a high powered five day tournament.

The 13th annual American 14.1 Straight Pool Championship is being held for the 4th year in a row at beautiful Diamond Billiards, 13184 Midlothian Pike, Midlothian, VA 23113 which is considered one of the premier billiard rooms in Virginia. “The Scorpion” BCA Hall of Fame
4x World 9 Ball Champ



b. 1968, Twin City, Georgia

Johnny Archer began playing pool at 12 and turned pro in 1986. He is the owner of a beautiful 40 table room, Marietta Billiard Club, 1355 Roswell Road, Marietta, GA 770-579-3388. He married his wife Melanie in 2002 and they have two young children. Today he is recognized around the world as one of the game's few paragons. His credits are truly legendary and he has won more than seventy professional tournaments. Among his top honors: 4x World 9 Ball Champion including back-to-back titles in 1993-94; Winner US. OPEN 9 Ball Title in 1999; World Championship 1st Place 1997; 7x Player of the Year and 1990s Player of the Decade! 12x member of the prestigious USA MOSCONI CUP TEAM. In 2009 Johnny was inducted into the BCA Hall of Fame and rightfully joined the elite giants of the sport that we all love. Johnny has recently helped to organize the ABP, Association of Billiard Professionals, whose focus is to improve the standards for pro players. 2011 was Johnny's first visit to our tournament, and he showed his stripes for sure, besting John Schmidt in the finals 150-74. This year marks Mr. Archer's 6th visit to us and it is indeed an honor to have a fine gentleman here on our doorstep.

To say that Karen Corr is a big name in the sport of women’s professional pool would be a significant understatement. In a career spanning almost three decades, the last two in US, the native of Northern Ireland has won everything there is to win in pool, including 15 Classic Tour titles, four BCA Open titles, three WPBA National Championships and three Tournament of Champions titles. In 2012 Karen was rewarded for her accomplishments with the greatest accolade of them all, induction into the Billiard Congress of America (BCA) Hall of Fame. Shortly after winning her 4th World Snooker title in 1997, Karen moved to the U.S. in 1998 and switched her game to 9-ball racing through one WPBA qualifier after another in pursuit of a Classic Tour card. After just six months Karen was ranked 24th in the WPBA and rose to No.4. In the years since she has competed equally with reigning Queens, Jeanette & Allison. One of a scant few courageous ladies to dip her cue into the world of 14.1, 2014 was Karen’s first visit to our tournament. And what a weekend she had defeating a staggering array of seasoned top 14.1 players, including 4 straight wins. Dominic Noe, and then an 80 ball run to send Mike Dechaine to the locker room, defeating NY’s great Tom Walter 150-122, and a gutsy come from behind win over Kevin Clark 150-149, before losing in the finals to tournament winner, Darren Appleton. Surely no disgrace, 2nd place vs. a very strong field of seasoned 14.1 players! Great job and you have spoiled us now, Karen, and welcome back for the 3rd time and thanks for your support of us and of 14.1.




Kai-Lun Hsu, Taiwan “Sai-Ya Superman”

**Mika Immonen, New York City, NY “The Ice Man”
4x World 14.1 Champion; World 10-Ball Champ;
2x US Open 9-Ball Champion; BCA Hall of Fame**



b. 1972 of Finnish descent, born in Paddington, England. Elected in 2014 to the BCA Hall of Fame, Mika needs no introduction and is known across the globe as one of the finest players to ever play this beautiful game not only in our generation, but for all time. A legendary player of every game, and a true ambassador of pool around the world. Mika has played in our tournament often in the past and we welcome him back. Mika, born near London, raised in homeland Finland, was the European 9-Ball Tour’s No. 1 player at 20. Four years after capturing his first major international title — the 1996 Peace Cup in Taiwan — Mika settled in New York City. A year later he won the World Pool Championship in Cardiff, Wales, topping a star-studded 128 player international field and grabbing what was then pool’s richest top prize — \$65,000. Mika was a dominant player throughout the 2000s, winning 10 pro titles in the U.S., including back-to-back U.S. Open 9-Ball crowns in 2008 & 2009. He added his second world title when he won the 2009 World 10-Ball Championship. Billiards Digest named the Ice Man “Player of the Decade” in 2010. He has added a handful of major titles since 2010, including the World Cup of Pool doubles crown in 2012. He has been a 14x member of Team EUROPE in the Mosconi Cup and was MVP in 2008. In Sept. 2016 Mika won his 4th World 14.1 title at Steinway Billiards in NYC. Mika has been a long and loyal supporter of our 14.1 and we appreciate it, Mika.


