She continued her education at the University of Arkansas, where she received her doctoral degree in Clinical Psychology. Since 1991 when Jonice became a licensed psychologist, she has been on national television with her discovery of CEN (Childhood Emotional Neglect) and mental health problems and recovery.

Roger Johns graduated from Tonkawa High School in 1972 and received his Mechanical Engineering Degree from the University of Oklahoma. He has been on the leading edge of oil and gas technology for over 44 years. The absolute highlight of his career was in Chili, South America, where the horrible Copiapo Mine Rescue (Chilean Mining Accident) took place in August of 2010. Roger was part of the mine rescue team on site in Copiapo and supervised drilling

operations with his company's equipment. Sixty-nine days later, thirty-three miners were rescued from the collapsed mine shaft by drilling three simultaneous holes.



Dr. Michelle Jeffries Keylon, a 1990 Tonkawa High School graduate, holds a Doctor of Education Degree in Educational Leadership from North Central University, along with a Master of Science Degree In Occupational and Adult Education from Oklahoma State University, and a Bachelor of Science degree in Secondary Education – Business Professions from Oklahoma State University.
