# 2023 Distinguished Alumni



Dr. Cyndi Allen-O'Connor graduated from Tonkawa High School in 1973. She went on to earn her Bachelor of Science degree in Nursing from the University of Oklahoma, her Master of Science degree in Nursing from the University of Texas, and her Doctorate degree in Nursing Research from UT, as well. She served as a military Nurse Researcher at the Army Futures Command, Medical Capabilities Development Directorate at Joint Base San Antonio, Fort Sam Houston Texas for 18 years. She retired from the Army Nurse Corps at the rank of Colonel after 27 years of active duty.



Joe R. Kreger is a 1957 graduate of Tonkawa High School. He graduated from Northern Oklahoma College in 1959 with an Associate of Science degree and received his Bachelor of Science degree from Oklahoma State University in 1961. He taught at NOC for a few years, but eventually purchased the land now known as Kreger Ranch. Later in life, Joe began writing poetry. His poems have been published in two books and on 3 audio CDs. He has been appointed as "Poet Laureate of Oklahoma" twice, in 1998 and 2021.
