Set a Goal:

Do your Homework:

1. Study trustee bios on district website. Know professions, political parties, when up for re-election. See [PublicSq. | Connecting freedom loving Americans](#).
2. Understand trustee “district” boundaries. (School boundaries are different). **Which trustee works for you?**
3. Find next meeting’s agenda link. Start reading agenda and click on attached reports.
4. Follow directions to file a **Public Records Request** and ask for more information-ie emails, reports, meetings, powerpoint presentations, handouts.

5. Learn rules about speaking during “public comments” and on agenda items.

6. Learn about “**Consent Calendar**” items (usually mundane, budget items, but often very revealing info.

7. Watch YouTube videos of past meetings. Watch body language of board members/staff.

8. Which board member might likely support your proposal?

9. Make a lobbying plan.

10. Call to make appointment with your trustee. Go with a pal, not alone. Send thank you note.

11. Design flier with board members’ phones and email addresses. Send email blast.
