Parents code of conduct - Competition specific

This policy is specific to the conduct expected by families of gymnasts competing for C C Gymnastics club.

It is important for families to remember that when you are attending other gymnastics clubs or venues you are representing our club. C C Gymnastics as a club will be held responsible by hosting clubs for any inappropriate behavior or actions from gymnasts and parents. In such instances C C Gymnastics reserves the right to ban specific family members from future competitions at specific venues or from all competitions, in extreme circumstances this could also include the banning of your gymnast.

Parents should always...

Help your child to recognise good performance, not just results.

Publicly accept official judgements.

Set a good example by recognising good sportsmanship and applauding the performances of all.

Use correct and proper language at all times.

Set a good example to your child by always speaking positively about other gymnasts and other gymnastic clubs.

Parents should refrain from..

Challenging or arguing with coaches and officials.

Shouting across to coaches or gymnasts whilst the competition is running

Punishing or belittling a child for poor performance or making mistakes.

Entering the competition floor area

Taking your gymnasts out of the competing area whilst a competition is still running

When competitions are using K-Score parents and families should not inform their gymnasts or other gymnasts of the live scores or placings and should ensure their

other children/gymnasts don't do this either. Families should not share these results with coaches whilst a competition is still ongoing unless they specifically ask for them.

And can I remind all families prior to competitions they should never contact other clubs to regarding competitions timings, scores or any other information. All enquires of this nature should go through our center manager.
