

Warren County Conservation District High School Scholarship



The Warren County Conservation District will award one \$1,500 scholarship per county and city high school (5) in Warren County, KY to qualifying high school seniors. This award is a need-based award and will be administered through The College Heights Foundation. The scholarship will be allocated evenly over two semesters, half will be administered at enrollment and the remaining funds will be received at the beginning of the following semester with a documented minimum 2.5 GPA.

Student eligibility for the Warren County Conservation District Scholarship:

- An academic performance with minimum of 2.5 GPA.
- Applicant must pursue a major in agriculture, natural resources, agriculture/conservation engineering or related fields. Chemistry or biology is acceptable if the applicant intends to have a career in a conservation or agricultural related field.
- Preference is given to high school seniors with financial need.
- Home-schooled applicants, please state that you are home-schooled and list your coordinating school district. You will be among the applicants from your district.

Applicants must complete the application and submit the following:

- A current transcript from their high school

Without the above documents, applications will not be considered.

5. Prior to the **second semester** you must submit your transcript for the 2021 Fall Semester to receive the second portion.
