Contingent Gift Language

HCCT can be named as a contingent beneficiary in your will or personal trust if one or more of your specific bequests cannot be fulfilled:

<u>Residual Gift Language</u> (can be used in addition to the above specific or contingent gift, or as an alternative to the gift). A residual bequest comes to us after your estate expenses and specific bequests are paid:

I give and devise to the Hill Country Community Theatre, Inc., currently located at 4003 FM 2147, Cottonwood Shores, TX 78657, a 501(c)(3) public charity (Federal Tax ID Number 2491250), all [or state a percentage] of the residue of my estate, both real and personal to be used for its general support (or for support of a specific fund or program).]

Retirement Plan Beneficiary Language

You may name the Hill Country Community Theatre, Inc., currently located at 4003 FM 2147, Cottonwood Shores, TX 78657, a 501(c)(3) public charity (Federal Tax ID Number 2491250) as a beneficiary of your IRA or other qualified retirement benefits. Donors should consult with their tax advisor regarding the tax benefits of such gifts.

Naming the HCCT as the beneficiary of a qualified retirement plan asset such as a 401(k), 403(b), IRA, Keogh or profit-sharing pension plan will accomplish a charitable goal while realizing significant tax savings. It can be costly to pass such assets on to heirs because of heavy tax consequences. By naming HCCT as a beneficiary of a retirement plan, the donor maintains complete control over the asset while living, but at the donor's death the plan passes to support HCCT free of both estate and income taxes.

Making a charitable gift from your retirement plan is easy and should not cost you any attorney fees. Simply request a change-of-beneficiary form from your plan administrator. When you have finished, please return the form to your plan administrator and notify HCCT. We can also assist you with the proper language for your beneficiary designation
