

## Ironstone TBEC 11th June 2023

## TBEC Report

Round 4 was held at Ironestone near to Northampton on the 11th June.

Matt Baker had stopped overnight and was already making tea when I arrived! The day was forecast to be hot and taking on lots of water was a key to surviving the day ahead!

The track was around 6 miles long and this included some fast flowing grass land, wooded sections and some steep valley climbs and a few man made log obstacles.



Due to the heat forecast for the day they decided to give riders the benefit of the doubt and allowed us to remain on the bikes through the blue sections rather than having to get off and push them through, which I was most agreeable with (nobody likes pushing bikes)!!

It all started at 10.30 and I was on row zero and Matt was a few rows back and the format for the day was a 2hr plus 2 hr with 1 hr in-between for lunch, I went off at my

usual pace and the first lap was a bit of a disaster, struggling for grip on the ice like grass which did not give you much warning before ceremoniously dumping me on my arse which then made me doubt the bikes ability to grip any surface, this resulted in a far from easy 3 or 4 laps trying to build up confidence again, thankfully I managed to get my head in gear and start to claw back some time and positions but over ran the first 2 hours by 4 minutes.





Lunch break was a good opportunity to get plenty of fluids in a d a quick snack, I also had a chat with Matt who was going well in the first half but decided to miss the afternoon ride as he had a busy adventure ride planned for the coming week and needed to ride up north on Monday!



After lunch I started much better and much quicker than normal and quickly found my way past a handful of quick riders mainly due to them slowing up due to the heat or fatigue as the race wore on also the track became a bit more bumpy and dusty in places which made some riders more cautious. I did have a bit of leg cramp 4 laps in but managed to work through it with the usual swear words and telling myself to get on with it even when you're not sure you want to try and stand up or sit down again!!





I found myself in 4th place out on the track at the half way stage of the afternoon just behind the leaders and managed to maintain the same pace right to the end of the race but knew I had a tall order to make up the lost 4 minutes from the first half! Matt and Eli were fantastic in the fuelling

area and with a lighting quick pit stop and a refreshing bottle of water thrown over my back it helped maintain the pace I was running! All said and done I was much happier with my riding and felt stronger than the last 2 previous meetings.



Happy with another strong ride and overall position 7th out of the 139 finishers and 5th in class (Elite) and completed 14 laps.
