Enjoy the last of the "summer wine!" Now it's back to a normal schedule, ready or not. Last weekend most of the younger generation looked as if they were suffering from a bad dose of "back-to-school jetlag" – oh, the joys of life!

As you readjust your lives to early to bed and early to rise, parents please take note that this weekend, 31 August/1 September, will be the last weekend to register for the upcoming 2019/2020 CCE classes; after that, registration closes. Those of you who registered last year registered for that year only and not in perpetuity. Those of you who have not met with me to register have probably either found another parish that may now fit your needs much better, or worse, you have not been reading the bulletin because you haven't been to Mass here in the last few months. To put it very simply, we do not offer ongoing religious education (CCE) to those who do not practice their faith consistently. CCE is not a substitute for Mass. As parents, your example is paramount; it is the book from which your children are reading, and seriously, you can't ask your children to do or be something that you are not yourself. Religious practice, which includes the celebration of Mass with us every weekend, comes first; then, and only then, does CCE make any sense.
