
Please note that there is no CCE class this weekend or next because of Spring Break; after the break,

I wish you safe travels and a restful, refreshing Spring Break to one and all.

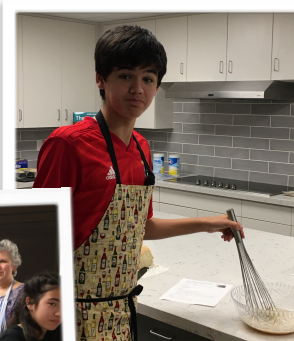
