Overall Summary

Spencer delivered an excellent all-around weekend, showing mature receiving ability behind the plate, strong game management skills, and high-quality contact at the plate. His defensive performance was the standout, with clean, reliable work behind the plate over 7 innings and a strong caught-stealing moment that showcased quick transfer and accuracy.

At the plate, Spencer showed disciplined at-bats, a line-drive approach, and 100% LD, which is a rare marker at this age and competition level.

Scout Take

- Spencer's line-drive rate is elite for 14U and shows how consistently he finds the barrel.
- His .500 OBP indicates advanced patience and strike-zone awareness.
- The lower OPS is primarily because he wasn't driving the ball for extra bases beyond the double, but the underlying swing metrics (LD%) show projectable offensive upside.
- Shows the makings of a gap-to-gap hitter as he matures physically.
- Strikeouts (4) were present but were competitive: he still worked counts and maintained a high OBP.

Offensive Summary

Productive, selective hitter with an advanced line-drive approach. Strong on-base profile and barrel consistency give Spencer clear long-term offensive projection.

Scout Take

Spencer's strongest value comes from behind the plate:

- ✓ Reliable receiver quiet glove, presents pitches well
- ✓ Good blocker especially on low glove-side breaking balls
- ✓ Strong game IQ communicates well with pitchers and infield
- ✓ **Quick transfer** caught one stealing due to footwork + release
- ✓ **Durability** 7 innings straight shows stamina and focus

His ability to manage a pitching staff at 14U is ahead of the curve, and he shows clear traits of a future varsity catcher.

Defensive Summary

A dependable defensive catcher with natural receiving actions and improving arm strength. Leadership behind the plate stands out.

While the weekend's workload was primarily catching, Spencer's athleticism translates well to the outfield:

- Clean routes
- Good first step
- · Adequate arm strength for age
- Reads ball off bat well

Projection Report

Offensive Projection (14–16U)

- Gap-to-gap hitter with chance for pull-side power
- High barrel rate → future increases in SLG
- On-base ability will stay a major strength
- K% will improve as timing sharpens versus higher velocity

Defensive Projection

- Varsity-level catcher traits already present
- Arm strength should naturally climb to 72–76 mph POP ranges over next 12–18 months
- Blocking and receiving will remain top-tier strengths
- Has the defensive IQ to stay behind the plate long-term
