Summer Camp Details for Middle & High School @ Forest Home July 6-11th 2025

Location: Forest Home summer camp is at 40000 Valley of the Falls Dr, Forest Falls, CA,

which is 2.5 hours away, near Big Bear. Middle School (entering 6-8th) stays at

"Creekside" and high school (entering 9-12th) stay at the "Lakeview" side of camp.

Dates: We depart from church July 6th at 12 noon and return Friday July 11th at 3pm.

Cost: All meals, lodging, activities, and transportation are included for \$695. Students may

visit the gift store and snack bar during free time. Cashless system info given later.

Program: We meet with different middle and high school students from churches around SoCal.

We gather in the mornings and evenings in the amphitheater for powerful worship music and Christ-centered inspiring speakers. We engage in different activities and cabin discussions in our particular cabins with our church groups as we draw closer

to God and one another in meaningful ways.

Food: The food is good with healthy portions and various options. We eat together at des-

ignated church tables for breakfast, lunch, and dinner at our respective camp sites

(Creekside & Lakeview). Food allergies can be accommodated with notice.

Cabins: Cabins are bunk-bed style with separate cabins for boys and girls. Each includes pri-

vate bathroom and shower stalls. There are usually 6-8 people to a room from our

church. Friends will be matched together in cabins.

Free Time: Free time is daily between lunch and dinner. Students have multiple activities to

choose from: swimming in the lake, pool, zip lines, climbing walls, crafts, miniature

golf, or hanging at the really nice main lodge snack bar. It is a beautiful camp!

Leaders: There are designated camp leaders as well as a camp director who live at FoHo dur-

ing the summer. Our Monte Vista youth ministry leaders go as well to facilitate dis-

cussions and relationships.

Medical: Each camp has it's own designated nurse with additional medical assistance available

at the main camp. All medication is turned in at the beginning of camp to the nursing

staff. It is provided during meals and available 24-hours a day with supervision.

How do I register my child for a great week at camp?

1. Go to <u>www.MonteVistaNP.church</u> and click on the registration link. This takes you directly to the Forest Home website where you complete BOTH personal information and medical info.

- 2. Payment options in two ways: After registration, return to the Monte Vista church website and click on the "Payment" option to pay online using your credit card. Or write a check to Monte Vista Presbyterian Church with "Forest Home" and child's name in the memo. Or...(see below)
