Nearly 80 people attended and camped at Big Bear; 65 Middle and High School Students, 8 college leaders and the balance being adult advisors. He is Lord of all and Savior". To breathe in is also a reminder to receive His Holy Spirit to guide us, help us, gives us the ability to experience peace, forgiveness and eliminate doubt.

HONDURAS MISSION TRIP

Want to join the Mission Team in serving down in Roatan, Honduras this summer July 18-28th? Our purpose is to continue the relationships with a church on the island called Alpha Community Church and Pastor Hank Stanley. We will support their outreach to their local community, to expand our own worldview on how others worship Jesus Christ, and to better understand our own sense of calling using our gifts when we return. We will be working with children, caring for the elderly by bringing food and praying with them in their homes. We will also be building/cleaning/painting alongside others in the church, worshipping together in various church services, exploring the island with fun, and sharing meaningful discussions as a team while learning from local leaders.

Why Roatan, Honduras? Pastor Matt's first youth group started down there 25 years ago while living there as a missionary. Pastor Matt's wife and kids have continued relationships through Pastor Hank and his family. Pastor Hank has preached here at Monte Vista several times and our church has sent mission teams there last two summers, showing how God is continuing the partnership to learn and serve together while on different continents.

Feeling called? We will have an information meeting Sunday March 9th at 11am in the youth room and will share all the details, including costs, team training and next steps. Once the team of 14-16 is complete, the first team meeting will be March 30th.


