with R 400.5205a. Form	ula, Milk, Foods, PROVIDED BY PARENT, ASA Prep shall assure that the food, formula,
bottles, nipples and cont	ainers comply with all of the following provisions:

- a) Formula shall be prepared at the child's home and placed in assembled, ready-to-feed bottles before being brought to ASA Prep.
- b) Formula, milk, and food shall be covered and labeled as to the contents, date, date of preparation, when applicable, and the name of the child for whom its use is intended.
- c) Formula, milk and perishable foods shall be refrigerated until used.
- d) At the end of the day, any formula or milk in an unopened ready-to-feed bottle, or perishable food shall be returned to the parent or discarded.

ASA Prep shall also comply with R 400.5205a (2) Regarding breastfeeding and the handling and storage of breast milk:

- a) ASA Prep shall accommodate breastfeeding
- b) ASA Prep shall have a designated place set aside to accommodate mothers and their children who are breastfeeding.
- c) Expressed milk shall meet the following requirements:
 - i. Arrive at ASA Prep in clean, sanitary, ready-to-fee bottles labeled with child's full name and bearing the date of collection.
 - ii. Be immediately stored in the refrigerator or freezer upon arrival at ASA Prep and kept refrigerated until used or discarded.
 - iii. Be thawed under cold running water or in the refrigerator and shall be used within 24 hours.
 - iv. Be discarded at the end of a feeding.

- Table Food (MUST BE IN MICROWAVEABLE CONTAINER WITH LID.
LABELED WITH CHILD'S NAME AND DATE)

1 - Box of Small 8 gal. Garbage Bags

1 - Can of Lysol Disinfectant Spray
