## Begins January 2020

- ~ Wait until the Pat Slone Block of the Month arrives (distributed electronically on the 15th each month) and then come get both items; or
- ~ Come to the free Sew-In being held on the first Saturday after the 15th (BoM) release and get the whole kit 'n caboodle.
