

MPQ 2021 Paper Pieced Pattern

<u>Note:</u> This pattern is paper-pieced. If you are not familiar with paper piecing, there are excellent tutorials on-line that you can view, so the instructions will not be repeated here. Most of these are very simple. The exception is Letter Q, which is not difficult, but does involve Y seams.


Each block will finish at 5".


Cutting Instructions:


- 1. Complete all top and bottom Border units (Units A and B in each block)
 - Cut 14 strips 1 ½" x 4 ½" in black and white print
 - Cut 28 coloured squares 1 ½" x 1 ½"
- 2. Complete the Letter M
 - Black:
 - Cut 1 x (3 x 3 ½") for #C1
 - Cut 1 x (1 ½" x 4 ½") for #C7
 - Cut 2 x (1 ½" x 2 ½") for # C4 and #C5
 - Black and White Print
 - Cut 1 strip 1 ½" x 4 ½" in black and white print for #C9
 - White:
 - Cut 4 x (1 ½" x 4 ½") for # C2, C3, C6 and C8
- 3. Complete the Letter P
 - Black:
 - Cut 2 x (1 ½"x 4 ½") for #C10 and C12
 - Cut 2 x (1" x 4 ½") for #C9 and C11
 - Cut 1 x (3" x 2") for #C7
 - Cut 1 x (1 ½" x 2") for #C2
 - Cut 2 x (1 ½" x 1 ½") for #C5 and C6
 - White:
 - Cut 1 x (1 ½" x 4 ½") for #C8
 - Cut 2 x (2" x 1 ½") for #C1 and C3)
 - Cut 1 x (2 ½" x 1 ½") for #C4

- 4. Make the Letter Q. It is recommended that you complete the corner units and the center first. Tack the unpieced units to fabric. Trim all pieces along the outer edge and then start adding one unit at a time attaching each one to the D unit. Make sure you start and stop on the stitching line (leaving ¼" unstitched at the beginning and end). You may want to backstitch each stop/start. Once all the units are on the D unit, fold and stitch the sides of each piece.
 - Black:
 - Cut 1 x (3" x 3") for D3
 - Cut 1 x (1 ½" x 1 ½") for D2
 - Cut 2 x (1" x 1") for C2 and C3
 - Cut 3 x (1 ½" x 2") for E2, F2 and G2
 - Cut 1 x (1 ½" x 4 ½") for H1
 - Black and White Print:
 - Cut 1 x (1 ½" x 4 ½") for l1
 - White:
 - Cut 2 x (1 ½" x 1 ½") for D1 and C1
 - Cut 8 x (1 ½" x 2") for C4, K1, F1, J1, E1, M1, G1, and L1
- 5. Make two blocks of Number 2. For EACH block you will need:
 - Black:
 - Cut 4 x (1 ½" x 4 ½") for E1, E2, F1 and F2. For one block, substitute with a black & white strip for F2.
 - Cut 1 x (2 ½" x 2 ½"), cut on the diagonal, for D2 and D3
 - Cut 3 x (1 ½" x 1 ½") for C1, C5 and C6
 - White:
 - Cut 3 x (3" x 1 ½") for D1, D4, and C4
 - Cut 2 x (1 ½" x 1 ½") for C2 and C3)
- 6. Make the number 0
 - Black:
 - Cut 4 x (1 ½" x 4 ½") for C10, C11, C12 and C13
 - Cut 1 x (3" x 1 ½") for C1
 - Cut 2 x (1" x 1"), cut on the diagonal, for C5, C6, C8 and C9
 - White:
 - Cut 4 x (1 ½" x 3") for C2, C3, C4 and C7
- 7. Make Number 1
 - Black:
 - Cut 3 x (1 ½" x 4 ½") for C7, C9 and C10
 - Cut 1 x (1 ½" x 3 ½") for C5
 - Cut 1 x (1 ½" x 3") for C2
 - Cut 1 x (1 ½" x 1 ½") for C4
 - Black and White print:
 - Cut 1 x (4 ½" x 1 ½") for C8
 - White:
 - Cut 2 x (1 ½" x 3") for C1 and C6
 - Cut 1 x (2" x 1 ½") for C3
















Letter P block
