

Pastor Hoeppner's Message

Dear Faith Family,

The month of May has many special days and observances. For example, Mother's Day, Memorial Day, Ascension and even my 40th birthday. Yikes! But there is one day that I wait all year for, The Day of Pentecost. This year, we observe Pentecost on Sunday, May 23rd. This day has been observed by God's people for over three thousand years.

In Leviticus 23, it is all called The Feast of Weeks of Shavuot. It was 50 days after Passover and it was the 2nd annual festival in which God's people were to bring grain offerings to the temple in Jerusalem. In Jesus day, it also had an emphasis of God giving the Law and Old Covenant at Mount Sinai. At Mount Sinai, there was fire, smoke, and wind in which God gave His covenant to His people.

After 50 days after the resurrection of Jesus, thousands of Jewish people made their pilgrimage to Jerusalem to offer their grain offerings and to commemorate God giving the Law to them. But there would be different types of fire and wind. There would be new tongues of fire and God gave His firstfruits of the Spirit to His people. The disciples gave the firstfruits of the New Covenant in which they announced that God's grace was for all. That there is no other name in heaven and earth in which we must be saved. They proclaimed salvation in Jesus.

As you observe the many days this month, think about one of the greatest days of the church year, Pentecost. Let God kindle in our hearts faith, hope and love.

Our English District is launching a new model for funding missions to which every congregation is invited to participate. It is completely voluntary but we believe that as God's people see and hear what is being accomplished specifically and directly in support and development of new missions and enhancing existing missions, more and more of us will want to be involved. This funding model is based on the belief that "there is power and strength in many giving a little." Loving our neighbor includes caring for their spiritual well-being. This is why the need exists for God's people to come together in support of missions that are bearing kingdom fruit. It's simple. Very simple. It is NOT burdensome, nor sacrificial. It involves every baptized member of the Body of Jesus in your congregation, from the newest baby baptized to the oldest member. It demonstrates the power of the beautiful body of Christ working together, prompted by faith. It shows how much can be accomplished by many, giving little. \$1/per baptized member of our district congregations did ONLY this plan, we could produce \$2.5 million in addition to our district's total budget of \$1.8 million. The numbers are staggering. Just think what else we could do! Through the next year, Faith Lutheran will adapt this new model. There will be a plastic case in the back of the church where the money can be placed. This will replace our current mission of the month program.

<u>Week of May</u> 23 - Pentecost/Holy Spirit - **1 John 4:2** - By this you know the Spirit of God: every spirit that confesses that Jesus Christ has come in the flesh is from God.
