

# PRE-NURSING READINESS & EDUCATION PROGRAM (PREP)

## PROVIDING THE PREREQUISITE COURSES NEEDED TO APPLY TO NURSING SCHOOL

### 1. Who are these courses designed for?

These courses are for healthcare workers in Burnet, Llano, and Blanco counties who need the prerequisite classes to submit a strong application for the LVN or Associate Degree RN programs at Central Texas College-Marble Falls.

### 2. Do I need to work in healthcare?

Individuals who have prior or current experience in healthcare (clinical, clerical, medical billing & coding, or administrative) who are preparing for the next step into nursing are preferred, but not required.

### 3. Do I need to have already started prerequisites?

No. You may be just getting started or completing remaining prerequisites that are now offered at Central Texas College-Marble Falls.

### 4. What prerequisites are required for the LVN program?

At Central Texas College-Marble Falls, prerequisite courses for LVN are Pharmacology and Anatomy & Physiology I.

### 5. What prerequisites are required for the Associate Degree RN program?

At Central Texas College-Marble Falls, prerequisite courses for Associate Degree RN are Pharmacology, Anatomy & Physiology I, Microbiology and English Composition.

### 6. Is this a remedial program?

Prerequisites at Central Texas College-Marble Falls earn college credit on your college transcripts. A not-for-credit math remediation course is available for students who need help passing the math portion of the TSI. Passing all three components of the TSI is required for entrance into prerequisite courses.

### 7. What the TSI?

**Texas Success Initiative (TSI) Assessment** is a state-mandated program in Texas designed to measure college readiness in reading, writing, and mathematics for higher education.

## 8. What kind of academic support is provided?

Academic support is built into PREP for Anatomy & Physiology I, Microbiology, and Pharmacology. As part of PREP, students are required to participate in facilitated study groups and attend academic tutoring sessions.

## 11. What is the time commitment for prerequisites?

In-person attendance is required three nights per week, 3 hours each night. Expect 10–15 hours per week of personal study time outside of class.

## 12. Where are the courses held?

All courses are held at Central Texas College-Marble Falls, 806 Steve Hawkins Pkwy, Marble Falls, TX.

## 13. Can I keep working while taking these courses?

These courses are designed with healthcare workers in mind. Attendance is required 3 evenings per week, and some people may need to modify their work schedule.

## 14. How many spots are available?

We are accepting 24 pre-LVN students and 25 pre-RN students.

## 15. What happens after I complete the prerequisites?

The HESI exam is the next step in applying to a nursing program. The preparation for this exam is part of PREP.

## 16. What scores do I need to make to be eligible for nursing school acceptance?

You must earn an **A or B** in all prerequisite nursing courses. High grades in prerequisite classes and a passing HESI-A2 score will qualify you to apply to nursing school at Central Texas College-Marble Falls.

## 17. Where will I attend nursing school?

The goal of PREP is to prepare you to submit a competitive application to Nursing School at Central Texas College-Marble Falls.

## 18. When do I need to apply to Central Texas College-Marble Falls?

IMMEDIATELY. The first step is to complete the free online application for acceptance into Central Texas College. Once you are selected to participate in PREP, you will register for classes. It is not a fit if you need broad academic remediation, are not committed to the rigors of nursing school, and do not plan to work in Burnet, Llano or Blanco County after graduating from Nursing School.
