Programme overview

At this point, if you are reading this document, congratulations you are considering undertaking a period of supervised learning and mentorship following some initial training.

The programme is specifically aimed at community physicians wishing to upskill their generic PoCUS skills. However, it is within the remit of this programme to mentor you through alternative competencies providing you have undergone some basic ultrasound training, for example the 5-week course with ORCA medical which covers Physics, Knobology and an understanding of how to apply ultrasound into daily practice.

The Programme Involves

1. Development mentoring period is from 3 to 6 months.
2. **90 scans** to be reviewed and extensive feedback provided.
3. **2x private 1:1, 2-hour webinars** with your mentor.
4. Review and detailed analysis of your **logbook** which will include all of your ultrasound scans.
5. End of mentoring ultrasound image and CINE exam.
6. **Face to face assessment day**
7. **Competency sign off and certificate** following successful completion of all the elements above.
