Treasurer's Message

Dear Belwood Residents,

As we begin the new year, the Board would like to share a brief update on our community's financial health, along with a few important reminders regarding your 2026 HOA dues.

2025 Financial Year in Review

We closed 2025 in a strong financial position, ending the year with approximately **\$98,000** in our operating accounts and **\$285,000** in reserves. During the year, we contributed **\$40,000** to the reserve fund.

The reserve fund is used for major, planned repairs and replacements. In 2025, these funds allowed us to complete several key projects, including:

- Replacement of the Belwood monument at the main entrance
- Full replacement of the cabana roof

Looking Ahead to 2026

For the coming year, the Board has approved a target reserve contribution of **\$43,000**. To create a more consistent funding pattern and simplify bookkeeping with CMIS, we are transitioning from a single year-end lump-sum contribution to **monthly reserve contributions**.

Annual Dues & Portal Access

Invoices for annual HOA dues were mailed in December. If you have not yet submitted your payment, please do so at your earliest convenience.

To be eligible to serve on the Board, you must be a Class A member in good standing (i.e., no unpaid dues).

If you have any questions about serving on the Board, please contact a current Board member so we can fill you in on what you can expect. Serving on the board is a fulfilling way to contribute and make a positive, lasting impact on the Belwood community.

We also have several standing committees for the Board that can be filled by anyone interested in helping the HOA and you don't have to be a board member.

Events Committee - help organizing parties such as Halloween, 4th of July, etc.;

Facilities Committee - help the Board with Cabana projects and with securing contractors;

Legal Committee - help the Board with projects such as the Mirassou school development and CC&Rs revision;

Technology/Communications Committee - help with the HOA website and publishing the Belringer.

CC&R's UPDATE

The Board is continuing the process of updating the HOA Bylaws and consolidating the seven separate sets of CC&Rs governing the Association into a single document, while also revising the CC&Rs to comply with current California law. (<https://belwoodhomes.org/ccrs>). We have budgeted for this long and expensive process and have hired legal counsel to assist with the process. In the next several months, we expect to have a vote to approve the updated CC&Rs and By-laws. **IT IS VERY IMPORTANT THAT EVERYONE WHO RECEIVES A BALLOT (BY MAIL OR ELECTRONICALLY) RETURN OR SUBMIT THAT BALLOT.**

Calling All Teens Interested in Becoming Lifeguards This Summer

Looking ahead to summer, we're excited to welcome new and returning lifeguards to the Belwood Pool team! Lifeguarding at Belwood Pool is a rewarding way to develop skills, stay active, and be part of our community.

Teens must be at least 15 years old by the last day of the Red Cross lifeguarding course and complete a pre-course swimming skills test. The American Red Cross lifeguarding classes in San Jose and Los Gatos teach essential water safety, accident prevention, and emergency response techniques. This year, lifeguard job openings will be posted on the Belwood Homes website at the beginning of spring, so check back soon for details.

The Cabana will be rekeyed around April 1st. Once the date is finalized, members will be able to purchase after-hours keys online, and we will update members with the dates to pick up the keys for the upcoming season.

Mirassou Property Development Update from Preserve Bellwood Neighborhood Association (PBNA)

We recently met with Jack Robson of Robson Construction to discuss updates to the proposed development planned for the Mirassou property.

During the meeting, Mr. Robson shared that the project plans have been revised to include 14 homes, one of which will be designated as an affordable housing unit. A key change from earlier versions of the proposal is that the previously planned ADUs (Accessory Dwelling Units) have been removed.

In addition, the updated layout increases the distance between the new homes and the existing homes located behind the development wherever feasible. This adjustment is intended to improve spacing and enhance compatibility with the surrounding neighborhood.

The project is expected to be submitted to the Town Planning Commission in the coming weeks as part of the formal review process.

PBNA plans to hold a community meeting in **March** to share additional details, provide updates, and give residents an opportunity to ask questions and offer input.
