#### **President's Message**



Summer is here, and with it comes the joy of warm days, laughter, and the simple pleasure of gathering with neighbors at the pool. Whether you're diving in for a swim or just soaking up the sunshine, we can't wait to see our community come together for another great season!

Swim season is officially here and we are excited to share with you some of our recent changes. This year, guest fees will **only apply if your guests are swimming**. **The \$5 fee** helps offset the cost of lifeguards, ensuring a safe and enjoyable experience for all. As we transition to a cashless system, all guest

fees must be paid <u>using the QR code provided</u> in the binder at the swim gate. Additionally, all residents using the pool must sign in at the binder upon arrival.

**Pickleball Pilot Update** Last August, we introduced a trial pickleball court, and the response from our community has been overwhelmingly positive. As we continue to evaluate interest, we are also gathering feedback from residents near the Cabana grounds. To keep this pilot going, please remember that court hours are **strictly** limited to 9:00 AM until dusk. Players **must sign-in** and adhere to all posted rules. Early play - before 9:00 AM - may result in the termination of this pilot, so we appreciate everyone's cooperation!

**Looking Ahead: 2025 Goals** We're excited for another year of improvements and community initiatives. Here's what's on our agenda:

- Expanding online payment options for facility rentals, after-hours key purchases, Class D dues, and pool guest fees.
- Finalizing updates to the CCRs and gathering neighborhood feedback.
- Finding cost-effective ways to enhance the Cabana for everyone's enjoyment.

We welcome your ideas! If you have suggestions for other projects the board should consider in 2025, please join us at our <u>monthly Board meetings—held on the **third Tuesday of each month** at 7:30 p.m. in the Cabana. Your input makes a difference!</u>

#### **Secretary's Message**

Greetings and Salutations Belwood Members:

Did you know that the Belwood neighborhood was developed in the 1960's, and our CC&R's have not been amended or updated (also known as restated) since then. CC&Rs (or Covenants, Conditions and Restrictions) are used to maintain property values and to protect the rights and interests of homeowners. It is a recorded legal document that describes property rights and obligations of the membership, such as restrictions on the use of property, member assessments (dues), enforcement powers, dispute resolution, etc.



A lot has changed since the 1960's, especially the laws governing HOAs, and legal experts recommend updating CC&Rs every 5 to 10 years. For some unknown reason, rather than referencing the original CC&Rs, each time a new part of the Belwood neighborhood was developed, they recorded a new set of CC&Rs. So Belwood has 7 sets of CC&Rs (all of which are substantially similar) and can be found here:

Your Board has begun the process of amending all 7 sets of CC&Rs, including the associated By-laws, for the Belwood neighborhood. We have budgeted for this long and expensive process and have hired legal counsel. Some of the reasons we are amending our CC&Rs is to have 100% consistency among the 7 sets of CC&Rs, eliminate obsolete provisions that are no longer enforceable, to be compatible with the current HOA laws (Davis-Stirling), improve ambiguous provisions, provide for changes in technology and to conform to the original purpose of the HOA (establish, operate & maintain a social and recreational community center - the Cabana).

Later this year, we expect to have a vote on the recommended changes to the CC&Rs and By-laws. We will need everyone to return their ballots to ensure the process is done right.

We also have some standing committees for the Board that can be filled by anyone interested in helping the HOA and you don't have to be a board member to help.

- Facilities Committee guidance on Cabana projects and help on securing contractors;

#### **Summer Swim Lessons for all ages**

#### You do not have to be a Belwood resident for swim lessons, tell your friends.

Let's all learn to be pool safe and have some fun!

Belwood Cabana Club is offering swim lessons this summer. We provide quality classes from skilled, certified instructors. Class sizes are small to ensure all students are given ample attention. Our sessions run Monday-Friday and are scheduled throughout the summer. All lessons are 30 minutes duration 11:30 am , 12:00 pm or 12:30 pm. Cost per Two week Sessions: \$250 for group lessons or \$500 for private lessons. In August only is a 1 week session Cost per one week Sessions: \$125 for group lessons or \$250 for private lessons. Note you can not hire your own coach to do swim lessons that is against our liability insurance policy. The rule for private lessons - only allowed if the instructor provides liability insurance and pays to rent pool space just like swim team and Ladies swim fitness is required to do. Private lessons would need to be scheduled into an available time slot.

# Santa Clara Valley Mineral /Gem Society


We are a group of Rock, Mineral and Jewelry enthusiasts that meet on the fourth Tuesday of each month at The Cabana Club.
