## Mustraous Location

While the American Colonists were fighting to gain their independence in 1777, Charles III of Spain was rewarding the Mission Indians with homesites to be chosen from land which

includes your home site now being developed in "Belwood of Los Gatos".

Father Sierra, through the Spanish Viceroy of Mexico, obtained a reservation of 66,000 acres west of Guadalupe Creek from the Santa Clara Mission on the north, southerly to Almaden and to the Santa Cruz Mountain Summit for the 1500 Mission Indians to choose from for their individual homes. Your "Belwood" site most probably was included in the reward given to "Unanhum" (Umunhum) who established his home near the peak now carrying his name.

The Indians were rewarded with this gift to atone for the Spaniard's taking their original home land and for the hard work and service they rendered in building the Missions and developing the tree lined Alameda Drive, California's first two way Drive, from Pueblo

San Jose to Santa Clara Mission.

History records that Captain John Fremont, with "Kit" Carson as his guide and scout, made camp on the grassy knolls and flats just outside Los Gatos Gorge. Carson pastured his horses in this area, and most probably on this property with its secluded green grazing land. From this camp, in 1846, Fremont explored the Guadalupe Mines that are located a half mile southeasterly. The Cinnebar ore (Quicksilver) mined at the Guadalupe and New Almaden Mines was a real "prize". The Spaniards, British and Americans all hoped to acquire this area for their own benefits. Based upon Fremont's evaluation of the mines, Alex Forbes, the second white settler in Santa Clara Valley, with others, purchased and successfully operated the mnes.

## LOS GATOS - "the cats"


In the early 1850's Zadok Figgs built a "shake" house just about at the present site of the Union School. The Ridley Ranch of Riggs probably grazed its stock over this area. One of the ranches' employees in 1890 was Jack London, whom the area farmers of the time

termed "lazy" due to his preoccupation while writing "The Call of the Wild".

Major Lewis Foster Parker obtained this, the Belwood of Los Gatos property on January 7, 1870 from the United States Government Bureau of Public Lands. The Major was a militiaman and guardian of the costly quicksilver shipments from the mines. He was the first trustee of the Union School District, after whom the present Parker school is named. Undoubtedly the Major had his choice of many properties, but chose this one because of the proximity to the mines, the gently rolling graze land with the picturesque backdrop of the Los Gatos Foothills.


The property remained in the Parker Family until 1931 when it was acquired by the Bacigalupi family. For the next 25 years the property was developed and used as a dairy farm providing for the needs of the ever growing Santa Clara Valley.

Destiny must have ordained that now the pressures of the Valley's growth have made the site's ultimate use a reward to many people allowing them to partake of a part of this "history rich" land. Your homesite purchase should be your family's reward for hard work and service as originally, 200 years before, the property was the Indian "Umanhum's" reward for his hard work and service.


The construction of this facility is scheduled to coincide with the progression of the sales in the whole project.












The truly large family needs this home with—

all one level family room - living room area.












PLAN 76 SECOND FLOOR
