

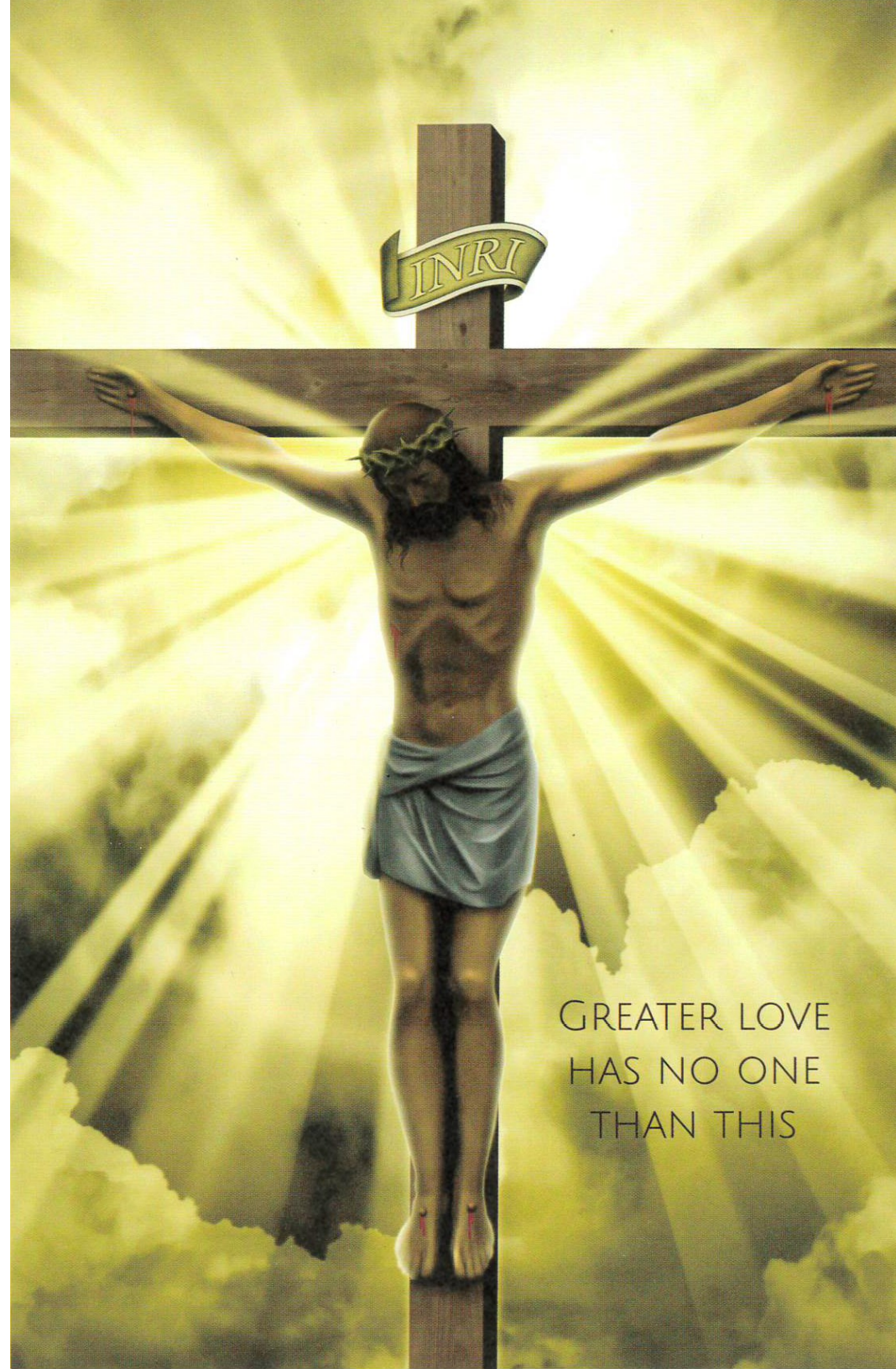

Thoughts as We Gather

Our text, the *First Reading* for Easter 6, demonstrates the urgency of the first-century believers (the apostle Peter, in this case) in proclaiming the crucified and resurrected Christ to all, for repentance and the forgiveness of sins. The *Psalms* is a joyful testimony that God's salvation is for "all the earth" (Ps 98:4). The *Gospel* reminds us that we did not choose Jesus; He chose us. When we "abide" in Jesus, the Vine, we bear fruit, which is identified in John and also in the *Epistle* from 1 John as *agapē*, a love that selflessly serves others.
