1. **Invocation** [Presider] **With a clean heart and spirit,**
[All] [+] let us adore and serve God, living and true.
2. **Hymn** [Cantor + All] Omit hymn if not sung.
3. **Antiphon First Psalm** [Psalmist]
4. **First Psalm** [All – Alternate Sides]
Continue to the end with the Glory to the Father ...
5. **Prayer** [Presider]
**[Repeat Antiphon is optional] [All]
6. **Antiphon Second Psalm** [Psalmist]
7. **Second Psalm** [All – Alternate Sides]
Continue to end with the Glory to the Father ...
8. **Prayer** [Presider]
**[Repeat Antiphon is optional] [All]
9. **First Reading** [Reader]
 - a. All pause for reflection
10. **Second Reading** [Reader]
 - a. All pause for reflection
11. **Responsory** [Reader – entire first line]
 - a. ALL repeat the whole first line
 - b. Follow the wording in the prayer book.
12. **Antiphon for the Gospel Canticles** [Psalmist]
 - a. ALL: [+] Blessed are you, God of Israel, ...
 - b. Final Antiphon [All]
13. **Intercessions** [Presider] **Only the first Line**
 - a. The reader prays the first half of the intercessions and
 - b. Everyone prays the **bolded part of the intercessions**
 - c. Personal petitions may be added.

14. Our Father [Presider] Gathering our prayers as one, we dare to say,
All: Our Father ...

15. Closing Prayer [Presider]

16. Blessing [Three Options (1) All, (2) Presider, or (3) Priest or Deacon]
[All make the sign of the cross +]
