Rights and Responsibilities of Camp Operators

NY State Sanitary Code Subpart 7-2 requires camp operators to provide parents with any Enrollment application forms the rights and responsibilities of camp operators:

- **To inform you and the local health department of any incident involving your child including serious injury, illness or allegation of abuse.**
- **To screen the background and qualifications of all staff and volunteers.**
- **To train staff about their duties.**
- **To provide supervision for all campers during hours of operation for day camps.**
- **To maintain all camp physical facilities in a safe and sanitary condition.**
- **To provide safe and wholesome meals.**
- **To develop, follow, and share approved camp safety plans.**
- **To provide you written notification during enrollment that:**
 - **the camp is required to be permitted to operate by Nassau County Department of Health;**
 - **the camp is required to be inspected twice yearly; and**
 - **The inspection reports and required plans concerning such camps are available for review at:**
