Panther Creek Guidelines...

In an effort to stay safe and ensure everyone feels as comfortable as possible, here are some guidelines we would like to follow for the weekend...

- Practice social distancing
- Leave appropriate space between vehicles
- Riders Only in the sign-up line (minors can have a guardian)
- Bring your own pen
- Print the entry form that is posted on-line and bring it with you to sign-up (filled out) ***Every rider must fill out an entry form, even if you raced with us at all this year***
- Print the gate form that is posted on-line and bring it with you (filled out)
- Bring exact change to gate & sign-up (study fees posted on-line/on the entry form)
- Please bring a **CLEAN** helmet to sign-up
- Saturday Riders Meeting(s) will be on the starting line
- **Sunday Riders Meeting will be near the scoring trailer at 9:45am (please space out)**
- Riders are only allowed 1 support person in the starting area
- Please keep away from the scoring area
- There will be NO trophy presentation(s). Trophies will be available for pick-up at Round 6. Prior to Round 6 there will be a list posted on-line of trophy winners so you'll know if you have one coming.

Until further notice we will adhere to our above guidelines and we appreciate your understanding & compliance.

We are excited to head back to Panther Creek! This property is MASSIVE and the possibilities are limitless! Each year we've added in some new trail here and there and we hosted the Off-Road Cup here this past August so many of you are already familiar with how great this property is.

Panther Creek is typical of most Missouri tracks, meaning it's fairly rocky and gravelly. There's sweet ups & downs, cool ravines and creek beds, a couple logging roads, and heaps of single-track. The crew has been hard at work and like I said before, if I get any mileage info or anything else, I'll be sharing that with you.

The 50 track is rider friendly and completely separate from all other courses! It is virtually all flat and the least rocky of anything on the property.

Concessions will be available throughout the weekend by the Chuck Schulte family (same folks that were at Eldon) – walking tacos, burgers, hot dogs, candy bars, sodas, water, coffee, and biscuits & gravy for breakfast.

Sometime over the weekend, please be sure to let the Panther Creek staff know how much we appreciate being able to come do what we love on their property! And, if you're passing through Eldon, stop by WHITTLES for an awesome meal with our MORE friends, the Scott family!

Keep in mind that there is VERY limited cell service at this location. That's okay though – all the cool kids that you'd want to talk to will be there anyway!!!

Saturday is our normal program while Sunday's program will be a different & unique format (please attend the *riders meeting at 9:45am Sunday* near the scoring trailer to get all the details):

- No practice
- Start time is 10:30 am
- Course will be around 20 miles long
- All classes race at the same time
- Short Course classes run 2 laps
- Long Course classes run 3 laps

Other Stuff:

Please keep your speed below 10 mph when you are not on the racetrack.

Bonecutter Offroad will be onsite with their rolling cycle shop to help with all your weekend parts needs.

Sign up BEFORE you practice (bring your forms) – respect the property – NO riding after dark.

Please make sure that your pets are on a leash at ALL times and remain at your vehicle. This was a problem at Training Grounds...please follow the rules or you/your rider could be penalized.

For first-timers to MORE, please take a minute to read through our Rules, and look over our Classes/Numbering lists. Every series does things a little differently than others - it's important that prior to race day that you are informed. One thing to note is our riders are required to display the appropriate number and background color on all three number plates during our events. If you do not have the correct setup, generics are available at signup for \$3/set of three.

Trophies from Training Grounds will be on a table outside of the scoring trailer. Holeshots awards from previous rounds are in the scoring trailer, just mention it when you signup.

Directions: From Tuscumbia, head South on Hwy 17 about 5 miles to State Rd A. Turn left on A and go 4 miles. Turn left on Humphrey Creek Rd (gravel) and then go 1 mile. Race entrance on the left.
