This coming weekend, August 13/14, we head to Knobby Creek in New Florence for another round of MORE racing.

First off, we owe a big thanks to our friends at Moto Europa in St. Louis, MO for being our event sponsor this round. Steve Smith has been a longtime supporter of the MORE series, he races every chance he gets, and he's the nicest guy you'll ever meet. We really appreciate his continued commitment to off-road racing and to MORE...please tell him "thank you for everything" when you see him this weekend.

Next up we need to give big props to our landowner, David Payne, for hosting us at his ultra-beautiful property this round. He loves dirt bike racing & gets a real kick out of seeing us all enjoy his place...be sure to pass along your thanks to him as well. We can't do what we do without awesome landowners like David.

We've said it before, this place has it all – ups, downs, logs, creeks, sweet dirt, and some rocky sections. And, there's sand...and mulch. The old school style moto sections (no real jumps, just rollers) are almost entirely covered with the sand/mulch mix making for great line options and increasing the fun factor.

The property received 2" rain Monday night and conditions are bordering on "all time".



Sportsman is around 5 miles, Sunday AM will be 6.5ish miles, and Sunday PM 7.5ish miles.

We've tried to stay away from the rockier sections and stick to the good dirt. Prepare to enjoy the MX343 Sand Wash, The Sidewinder, Herbie's Hot Tub, Fly Winder, and miles of sweet trail.

65/85/Ladies is 2ish miles and includes MX343 Sand Wash and the super tame moto track along with some awesome, mostly rock-free woods.

50 track is totally separate and is super fun trail with a little moto section and a trip past the lake. It's in the same location as last year if you were here. The start is out by the lake.

Lots of new trail – unique features – super mellow motocross sections freshly coated with sand and saw dust and tilled up. We even managed to get some sand into the woods just because.

Reminder that our course markings will be a combination of arrows, ribbon, and track tape. Saturday's Sportsman track and Sunday's Short Course track (the morning race) will be blue arrows. Most of these tracks will also have red arrows but there will be small sections of blue only. Red only is for Sunday's Long Course (the afternoon race). Remember: BLUE = Sport & Short / RED = Long.

Keep in mind that the Saturday and Sunday courses are different. Pink ribbon and blue ribbon will also be used.

The 50 Pee Wee course will be marked with black arrows on orange backgrounds and green ribbon. The 65/Ladies/85 sections will use black arrows on orange backgrounds and purple ribbon.

All trail splits will be marked with a SPLIT AHEAD sign followed by either BIG BIKES or 65/85/LADIES signs showing which way to go. It is up to you to know which one you are.

Do NOT ride in the yard (this is a residence)...parents let your kids know this please.

We have a super sweet track, an awesome lake for fishing & a beach for swimming (be responsible). There will be trophy presentations both days. We will have a PeeWee Party on Saturday. There will be TYKE racing Saturday @ 6pm. Fishin' for Frank Saturday evening @ 8. Lots of easy spectating & a beautiful property to spend the weekend at.

Find your card, sign the release on the back & bring to the scoring trailer window. If you are brand new to MORE or have not raced with us since 2020 or before, please fill out a new card, sign the release on the back & bring to the scoring trailer window.



Please bring a **CLEAN** (not dirty, not sweaty, not stinky) helmet to sign-up.

For first-timers to MORE, please take a minute to read through our Rules, and look over our Classes/Numbering lists. Every series does things a little differently than others - it's important that prior to race day that you are informed. One thing to note is our riders are required to display the appropriate number and background color on all three number plates during

our events. If you do not have the correct setup, generics are available at signup for \$5/set of three.
