

Policy: Tuition Refund Policy and Procedure

Background

Student Account Status

1) If tuition fees have not been paid in full and a student withdraws after the first day of class, the remaining tuition fees are still due. Summit West Independent School will take all steps necessary to collect fees owed to the school, including the use of collection agencies.

PLEASE NOTE:

- * Withdrawal requests must be submitted in writing and sent by registered mail to the Executive Director. Requests must include full disclosure for withdrawal.
- * Additional refunds will only be considered for medical reasons (suitable documentation by medical practitioner must be provided) or other hardship or exceptional circumstances.
- * Non-tuition fees, such as textbooks, uniforms, equipment, tournament fees, are non-refundable.
- * No reduction in fees will be made for absences, suspensions, expulsions, or withdrawals.
- *The school may suspend the attendance of any student with outstanding accounts unless otherwise agreed to in advance in writing.

IMPORTANT DEADLINES

REFUND

- 1) Withdrawal before June 1, refund of tuition fees paid, less \$250 admin fee.
- 2) Withdrawal before September 1, 50% of tuition fees paid, less \$250 admin fee.
- 3) Withdrawal on or after first day of classes, no refund applies, full tuition remains due.
