

Dynamic Diving Dogs FAQ's

Do I need a Registration number? Yes, you need to register your dog with Dynamic Diving Dogs to get a number so that we can track your splashes for titles. There is a 1 time fee for the life of the dog of \$10

How do I register? Registration forms are available on the B & D Creekside Website www.bndcreeksideactivitycenter.com under the Creekside Lagoon page.

There are 3 ways to register your dog for a number:

1. Fill out and mail the registration form and fee (checks payable to Creekside Event Center) to : Jill Almasy

2. Fill out the registration form and Email Jill Almasy at djalmasy@verizon.net

Then mail the registration fee to the above address

3. Register in person at the first event on November 12/13th.

Is there a minimum age to compete? Yes, we ask that all dogs be at least 1 year of age at the time of competition to compete. You may register your dog before their birthday.

How do I get a title? To get the first title in each event (Dynamic Distance, Arc Air, and Fast Fetch) you need to have 5 splashes within the title division in those events. Information regarding divisions and titles are available on the Dynamic Diving Dog link found on the Creekside Lagoon page. Title certificates will be emailed once a title requirement is met.

How much does it cost to compete? Dynamic Diving Dog entry fees are Per splash. Fee to enter is \$15 per splash preregistered or \$18 per splash for day of show registration.

What is a Splash? A Splash in Dynamic Distance consists of 3 jumps (an optional practice jump and 2 jumps – best of those two jumps counts as your score for that Splash) A Fast Fetch Splash consists of 2 speed retrieves, the best of which counts as your score. In the Arc Air event, the maximum distance at which the dog grabs or knocks down the bumper counts as the score (bumper is moved further out by 1 foot increments after each grab/knock down).
