RUNNING ORDER

Saturday Ring 1 begins at 8 am. Starts in Ring 2 and moves to Ring 1 immediately following the end of the class. It will alternate between rings after each class.
 Sunday Ring 2 begins at 8 am. Starts in Ring 1 and moves to Ring 2 immediately following the end of the class. It will alternate between rings after each class.

Please consult the AKC Regulations for Agility Trials for a complete description and eligibility for entry into these classes. The exhibitor is fully responsible for entering the dog in the correct class(es)/height divisions. Dogs running in a lower height division than they are eligible for will be eliminated.

HEIGHT DIVISIONS

All height divisions will be offered in the Standard classes, Jumpers With Weaves classes T2B and FAST classes. At the handler's option, dogs may be entered in a higher jump height class, except in preferred classes, where dogs must be entered in their measured height division. Dogs running in a lower height division than they are eligible for will be eliminated. The exhibitor is fully responsible for entering the dog in the correct class(es)/height divisions.

Entering For Exhibition Only (FEO)

- For Exhibition Only may be offered at the option of the host club. FEO will allow exhibitors to work with their dog in a trial environment. FEO is only allowed in all classes. Participation in FEO is non-qualifying.
- FEO runs are treated as trial entries. The exhibitor must enter the class(es) (T2B and/or FAST) prior to the closing date, pay class entry fee(s) and the Trial Secretary must record the entry in the Trial Catalog as part of the results for that class. FEO does not need to be noted on the entry form; the handler will declare the day of the show.
- Dogs may be entered in any jump height for FEO runs. If entered in an ineligible jump height, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show jump height changes are not allowed.
- Dogs may be entered in any level of FAST (Novice, Open, Excellent, Master). If the dog is not eligible for the level entered, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show level changes are not allowed.
- The exhibitor must declare FEO in the ring prior to leading out to the scribe and the judge.

(Note to Trial Secretaries – the above line has been updated to match the regulations. It had said: “The exhibitor must declare FEO in the ring prior to leading out.

NEW 24-INCH CHOICE HEIGHT – EFFECTIVE JANUARY 2, 2018

This new 24 Inch Choice jump height is for dogs entered in the Regular division that measure 22 inches and under ONLY. Dogs that measure over 22 Inches and are required to jump 24 inches will stay in the current 24 Inch height. Dogs measuring over 22 inches are not allowed to enter 24 Inch Choice. Additionally, dogs

that measure 22 inches and under at the withers may not be entered in the 24 Inch jump height on or after January 2, 2018. They may only be in the 24 inch Choice jump height. As is previously done with the 26 Inch class, the course times for the 24 Inch Choice will be the same as the 20 Inch height in all classes.

DOG ELIGIBLE TO ENTER

This trial is open to all dogs (15) months or age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or are register able breeds that have obtained an AKC, ILP or PAL number. Bitches in season, aggressive, blind, or deaf dogs or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance are ineligible to participate. Mixed breed dogs that have been listed with AKC Canine Partners may participate provided their listing number has been recorded on the entry Form.

Illegible entries will not be processed and will be returned to the exhibitor. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry and the Trial Secretary will add a \$30.00 collection fee to the amount of each returned check.

WAIT LIST INFORMATION

AAKA, Inc is offering a wait list to fill openings created by withdrawn entries after the trial's closing date/time. A maximum of 20 entries will be placed on the club's wait list. All entries, including wait-listed entries, must be received by the Trial Secretary prior to **April 11, 2026** at 6 pm. Any entries withdrawn after **April 11, 2026** at 6 p.m. will be replaced by a wait listed entry if any are available. If a withdrawn entry is replaced by a wait-listed entry, a full refund will be issued for the withdrawn entry. Any wait-listed entry that does not move off the wait list into the trial by **April 11, 2026** at noon will receive a full refund.

MOVE-UPS

Move-ups for the first trial day must be made in writing (email is fine) by **April 20, 2026** at 6 pm the Monday before the trial. There will be day-to-day move-ups at the show provided the Trial Secretary has received them within 30 minutes after the end of the last class.

A dog which has been entered in Novice "A" class for which it is not eligible to be entered in due to the class restrictions on the dog or the handler may be move to the Novice "B" class under the following conditions: The request for the move must be in writing and presented to the trial secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of each trial. The request must state the reason and justification for the move from a Novice "A" class to Novice "B" class.

COURSE WALK-THROUGHS AND WARM-UP INFORMATION

Handlers in all classes are permitted to walk the course, without a dog, during a walk-through period held prior to the start of the class. The walk-through is restricted to handlers entered in that class only. Handlers with multiple dogs, at events with multiple rings may request to walk with a height group other than the one their dog is entered in if a conflict is imminent.

A warm-up area, consisting of a regulation agility jump, may be provided for exhibitors. The warm-up area is to be used exclusively for warming up the dog and not for training or relieving of the dog.

OBSTACLES AND RING CONDITIONS

Obstacles will meet the specifications for obstacles in the current edition of the Regulations for Agility Trials. All classes will take place indoors and has heat/air conditioning on a field turf surface. Ring size will be 100' x 100'

ADDITIONAL SITE INFORMATION

Crating space will be available on a limited basis. The trial site requires a tarp to be placed on the floor underneath your crates. Crates may be left overnight; however, the **AAKA, Inc** and the

B & D Creekside Activity Center will not be responsible for any lost or damaged items left at the show site.

A full service food restaurant and bar is available on the site. There are various restaurants and fast food vendors within a very short driving distance.

Overnight parking will be allowed at the trial site. Electrical hook-ups for motor homes or campers are available.

Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dog(s). Any exhibitor failing to do so may be excused without benefit of refund if the Trial Committee deems the exhibitor to be in violation of this requirement. Cleaning supplies and disposal sites will be available at various locations around the show grounds.

RIBBONS, AWARDS, AND PRIZES

Ribbons will be awarded in each jump height division in each class as follows:

First Place.....	Blue
Second Place.....	Red
Third Place.....	Yellow
Fourth Place.....	White
Qualifying Score.....	Dark Green

In lieu of placement ribbons and qualifying ribbons handlers may choose a binder with pages for qualifying labels.

A New Title ribbon will be awarded to all dog and handler teams finishing a title. A MACH/PACH rosette and decorated MACH/PACH bar will be awarded to all dog and handler teams that attain their MACH/PACH.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

SAFETY, BEHAVIOR and LIABILITY

The safety of the dog is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely. It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create an unnecessary disturbance or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the trial committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made. AAKA and its agents, employees, etc., will assume no responsibilities for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children. AAKA reserves the right to decline entries for cause and may remove any dog on account of aggression. No one shall have any recourse or claim against AAKA or any official thereof. All dogs must be on leash at all times when on trial grounds except when in the designated warm-up area or competing on the course. Emailed entry changes are not official until the exhibitor has received email confirmation back from the Trial Secretary.

REFUNDS

No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee. No entry fee will be refunded in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by the action of the Trial Committee. Bitches in season are not permitted to compete in Agility Trials. As such, the club will refund entry fees less \$10 per day of the entry fee paid for bitches unable to compete for this reason upon presentation of a veterinarian certificate. This certificate must be presented to the Trial Secretary prior to the start of judging on the first day of the trial.

RINGSIDE

Judges are not required to wait for dogs. The Owner of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at ringside when it is to be judged. The Club has no responsibility for providing service through a public address system or stewards or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required.

This club agrees to arbitrate claims as set forth on the Official AKC Entry Form for this event.

Instructions

Handlers whose dogs measure into the 8" through 20" regular jump height divisions may opt to enter in a higher or 24-choice height division for all Regular titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs who measure into the 24" regular jump height division may not enter 24-choice. Dogs entered in the Preferred classes must compete at the required jump height and may not compete in a jump height division higher or lower than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial or back-to-back trials only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Dogs listed in the AKC Canine Partners Program may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.

Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler Number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 233-9767. If the Junior Handler is not the owner of the dog identified on the face of this form, what is the relationship of the Junior Handler to the Owner?
