Puppy Class from 5:00 – 6:00 pm, Mondays starting 1/24/22 Full

Puppy Class from 6:15 – 7:15 pm, Mondays starting 1/24/22 Full

Puppy Class from 7:30 – 8:30 pm, Mondays starting 1/24/22 Full

Prerequisites: Dogs need to be 10-weeks to 6-months old and must have current shots.

Description: The goal of the puppy class is to help you and your new puppy get to know each other and to introduce basic obedience concepts to the puppy. A major part of this class is socialization with other people and other dogs. This is done in a class setting where concepts of attention, walking on a leash, reliable recalls, impulse control, waits, and stays are introduced. AKC Star Puppy test is available at the end of this class.

Cost of class is \$100 for six weeks! Cost of class is \$90, IF you register, and pre-pay by January 14th.

Puppy Plus / Manners from 5:00 - 6:00 pm, Mondays starting 1/24/22 Full

Puppy Plus / Manners from 7:30 – 8:30 pm, Mondays starting 1/24/22 Full

Puppy Plus / Manners from 6:00 – 7:00 pm, Tuesdays starting 1/25/22 Full

Prerequisites: Dogs should have completed a puppy class or have equivalent skills. For small-breed dogs up to 18-months old, and large-breeds up to 12-months old with Instructor's approval.

Description: This class is designed for further socialization of young dogs. Basic skills of heeling, recalls, sits, downs, and stays will be reinforced. Training of manners for having a well-rounded family pet will be a focus of this class. Class will be fun and motivational with games and attention work to build a solid relationship with your young dog.

Cost of class is \$100 for six weeks! Cost of class is \$90, IF you register, and pre-pay by January 14th.

Foundations of Obedience I Class from 6:00 – 7:00 pm, Tuesdays starting 1/25/22 Full

Foundations of Obedience I Class from 7:15 – 8:15 pm, Tuesdays starting 1/25/22 Full

Prerequisites: Dogs should have completed a puppy class or have equivalent skills.

Description: This class will teach the foundation skills for having a well-rounded family pet, and for competitive obedience. Attention, heeling, sits and downs, sit/wait with attention, recall games, and stays will be covered. Class will be fun and motivational with games and attention work to build a solid relationship with your dog.

This class is also useful as a basis for dogs/handler planning on agility. **Cost of class is \$100 for six weeks! Cost of class is \$90, IF you register, and pre-pay by January 14th.**

Foundations of Obedience II Class from 6:00 – 7:00 pm, Thursdays starting 1/27/22

Prerequisites: Dogs should have completed the Foundations of Obedience I or have equivalent skills.

Description: Behaviors such as stay, coming when called, walking on-leash & off-leash, are practiced with distractions using creative, fun games and exercises. Teaching your dog to focus on you when the environment gets busy is essential to a happy life with your dog. This class provides excellent preparation for trainers interested in dog sports: agility, competition obedience, and rally obedience. The AKC Canine Good Citizen Exam will be available after this **Cost of class is \$100 for six weeks! Cost of class is \$90, IF you register, and pre-pay by January 14th.**

Speedway and Rodeo Dog Class from 5:00 – 6:00 pm, Wednesdays starting 1/26/22

Speedway and Rodeo Dog Class from 6:00 – 7:00 pm, Wednesdays starting 1/26/22 Full

Prerequisites: Dogs should have completed the Foundations of Obedience I or have equivalent skills.

Description: Speedway and Rodeo Dog results in well-rounded and conditioned dog. The dog enjoys moving around barrels, and through hoops and tunnels. The handler finds challenges deciding the best way to manage the dog through courses. Good teamwork can develop with any dog and handler team. Speedway and Rodeo Dog improves handling skills that can be incorporated for agility use. Instructor is Michelle Yackovich. **Cost of class is \$100 for six weeks! Cost of class is \$90, IF you register, and pre-pay by January 14th.**

Beginners Scent Work Fun from 7:15 – 8:15 pm, Tuesdays starting 1/25/22

Prerequisites: Dogs should have completed the Foundations of Obedience I or have instructor’s approval.

Description: This class will introduce you and your canine partner to the fast growing and popular sport of Scent Work. In this class you will learn how to stimulate and refine your dog’s desire to hunt by scent. By the end of this course, you will learn how to train your dog to hunt for specific odors. Equipment and gear overview will also be covered. *Cost of class includes beginners scent work kit.* Class instructors are Linda & Chuck Bowman. Class size limited to six dog/handler teams. **Cost of class is \$110 for six weeks! Cost of class is \$100, IF you register, and pre-pay by January 14th.**

Intermediate Scent Work Fun from 6:00 – 7:00 pm, Wednesdays starting 1/26/22

Prerequisites: Dogs should have completed the Foundations of Obedience I, Beginners Scent Work Fun or have instructor’s approval.

Description: This class builds on skills from Beginners Scent Work Fun, and introduces new skills. Class size limited to six dog/handler teams. **Cost of class is \$100 for six weeks! Cost of class is \$90, IF you register, and pre-pay by January 14th.**

Advanced Scent Work Fun from 7:15 – 8:15 pm, Wednesdays starting 1/26/22 Full

Prerequisites: Dogs should have completed the Foundations of Obedience I, Intermediate Scent Work Fun or have instructor’s approval.

Description: This class builds on skills from Intermediate Scent Work Fun, and introduces new skills. Class size limited to eight dog/handler teams. **Cost of class is \$100 for six weeks! Cost of class is \$90, IF you register, and pre-pay by January 14th.**

Therapy Dog Skills Class from 7:15 – 8:15 pm, Wednesday nights starting 1/26/22

Prerequisites: Dogs should have completed the Foundations of Obedience I & II or have instructor’s approval.

Description: This class will cover skills necessary to become a therapy dog. Class instructor is Pat Kelm. Class size limited to eight handler & dog teams.

Advanced Obedience / Rally from 7:15 – 8:15 pm, Thursdays starting on 1/27/22

Prerequisites: Dogs should have completed the Foundations of Obedience I & II or have equivalent skills.

Description: Traditional Rally class for those wanting to compete, and earn a Rally title. All levels of rally signs will be incorporated to meet individual needs of handlers. Drop-ins for this class are permitted. **Cost of class is \$100 for six weeks! Cost of class is \$90, IF you register, and pre-pay by January 14th.**
