## Class Schedule and Registration

### Foundations of Obedience I Class from 6:00 – 7:00 pm, Tuesday nights **FULL**

**Prerequisites:** Dogs should have completed a puppy class or have equivalent skills.

**Description:** This class will teach the foundation skills for having a well-rounded family pet, and for competitive obedience. Attention, heeling, sits and downs, sit/wait with attention, recall games, and stays will be covered. Class will be fun and motivational with games and attention work to build a solid relationship with your dog. This class is also useful as a basis for dogs/handler planning on agility. **Cost of class is \$100 for six weeks! Cost of class is \$90, IF you register, and pre-pay by October 2<sup>nd</sup>.**

### Foundations of Obedience II Class from 6:00 – 7:00 pm, Thursday nights **FULL**

**Prerequisites:** Dogs should have completed the Foundations of Obedience I or have equivalent skills.

**Description:** Behaviors such as stay, coming when called, walking on-leash & off-leash, are practiced with distractions using creative, fun games and exercises. Teaching your dog to focus on you when the environment gets busy is essential to a happy life with your dog. This class provides excellent preparation for trainers interested in dog sports: agility, competition obedience, and rally obedience. The AKC Canine Good Citizen Exam will be available after this class. **Cost of class is \$100 for six weeks! Cost of class is \$90, IF you register, and pre-pay by October 2<sup>nd</sup>.**

### Scent Work Fun Practice from 7:15 – 8:15 pm, Tuesday nights starting 10/13/2020

**Prerequisites:** Dogs should have completed the Foundations of Obedience I or have instructor's approval.

**Description:** Teamwork, and identifying your dog's signals, will be the focus of this class. Class instructors will be Linda and Chuck Bowman. Multiple scents, containers, and interior / exterior hides will be explored in this class. Different levels of abilities will be accommodated. **Cost of class is \$100 for six weeks! Cost of class is \$90, IF you register, and pre-pay by October 2<sup>nd</sup>.**

### Puppy Class from 6:00 – 7:00 pm, Monday nights **FULL**

### Puppy Class from 6:00 – 7:00 pm, Wednesday nights **FULL**

**Prerequisites:** Dogs need to be 12-weeks to 6-months old and must have current shots.

**Description:** The goal of the puppy class is to help you and your new puppy get to know each other and to introduce basic obedience concepts to the puppy. A major part of this class is socialization with other people and other dogs. This is done in a class setting where concepts of attention and walking on a leash are introduced. AKC Star Puppy test is available at the end of this class. **Cost of class is \$100 for six weeks! Cost of class is \$90, IF you register, and pre-pay by October 2<sup>nd</sup>.**

### Puppy Plus / Manners from 7:15 – 8:15 pm, Wednesday nights **FULL**

**Prerequisites:** Dogs should have completed a puppy class or have equivalent skills. For small-breed dogs up to 18-months old, and large-breeds up to 12-months old with Instructor's approval.

**Description:** This class is designed for further socialization of young dogs. Basic skills of heeling, recalls, sits, downs, and stays will be reinforced. Training of manners for having a well-rounded family pet will be a focus of this class. Class will be fun and motivational with games and attention work to build a solid relationship with your young dog. **Cost of class is \$100 for six weeks! Cost of class is \$90, IF you register, and pre-pay by October 2<sup>nd</sup>.**

**Competition Obedience Class from 5:30 – 6:30 pm, Thursday nights starting on 10/15/2020**

**Prerequisites:** Dogs should have completed the Foundations of Obedience I & II or have equivalent skills.

**Description:** Traditional CD/CDX class for those wanting to compete, and earn their CD and/or CDX.

**This class will run only if we have four handlers pre-registered.** Please check for availability of drop-ins before you show-up. **Cost of class is \$100 for six weeks! Cost of class is \$90, IF you register, and pre-pay by October 2<sup>nd</sup>.**

**Advanced Obedience / Rally from 7:15 – 8:15 pm, Thursday nights starting on 10/15/2020**

**Prerequisites:** Dogs should have completed the Foundations of Obedience I & II or have equivalent skills.

**Description:** Traditional Rally class for those wanting to compete and earn a Rally title. All levels of rally signs will be incorporated to meet individual needs of handlers. Drop-ins for this class are permitted. **Cost of class is \$100 for six weeks! Cost of class is \$90, IF you register, and pre-pay October 2<sup>nd</sup>.**
