## Schedule

Event Hours: Saturday \& Sunday 8 AM until completed.
These are CONCURRENT Events! We will run in groups of twenty-five, assigned by order of entry received. Day-of-Trial Entries will not close unless trial is over or meet maximum number of runs for each event.

Inspection: A rolling roll call will be used 7:30 am on Sat. \& Sun. All dogs will be inspected for soundness and measured prior to running each run. All bitches will be checked for being in-season prior to running. Multiple dogs will be spaced

## Course will be completely fenced in.

Fast Cat is a timed straight race of 100 Yards. Dogs run singularly
Dog's time to complete the 100-yard dash is converted into mph.
$18^{\prime \prime}$ or greater = handicap is 1.0
12 " up to less than 18 " $=$ handicap is 1.5
Below 12" = handicap is 2.0
Points = MPH multiplied by the dog's handicap
FAST CAT suffix titles are earned at designated milestones

## DCAT $=500$ points

FCAT = 1000 points
FCAT\# = each additional 500 points
Timing Devise: The time to complete the 100 -yard dash is recorded to the nearest $1 / 100^{\text {th }}$ of a second. The club will use break-the-beam equipment. In case of failure 2 stop watches will be used. An individual at the start line shall signal with an arm drop at the start line. When the nose of the dog crosses the finish line the stop watches will be stopped. The times from the two stop watches shall be averaged to determine the recorded time.

## GENERAL RULES

All Entries musts be one year of age or older on the day of the test.
Each entry will be examined and may be measured with a wicket at inspection. Inspection shall take place before any wraps are applied to the dog. Any entry found to be lame, unfit to compete, or female in season, shall not be allowed to enter and their entry fees shall be refunded. The decision of the field committee is final

Muzzles are permitted. Dogs may wear any type of flat quick release collar with NOTHING hanging from the collar. NO PINCH COLLARS, ELECTRONIC COLLAR OR FLEXI LEADS ARE ALLOWED ON SITE.

Electric continuous loop machines will be used. Lures consist of white plastic bags
Field committee reserves the right to bar aggressive dogs from the event site.
There is a $\$ 15.00$ fine assessed for any loose dog not taking part in the course progress (per AKC). The following actions may result in the fine and/or being excused from the event: exhibiting unsportsmanlike conduct, not picking up after one's dog, or littering in the event.

1. No One is permitted on the field without the express permission of the Field Chairman, except the appointed Field Committee.
2. There is NO SMOKING in the following areas: In and around the Paddock area, in and around the Secretary's table, and nowhere on the field itself. Please be respectful of others. Those who repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the trial committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made.

## RV PARKING
