- Entries received without fees or correct fees** will be returned to sender. Credit cards cannot be accepted. Make fees payable in US FUNDS. Trial secretary assumes no responsibility for cash sent through the mail. Post-dated checks and returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee.
- No entry shall be made** and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any conditions as to its acceptance.
- Exhibitors will pay** all bank charges for bounced checks. Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitors may result in their being put on a **CASH ONLY** basis.
- Declination of Entries.** Westmoreland County Obedience Training Club may decline any entries and may remove any dog on account of disease, viciousness, or other cause and no one shall have any claim against WCOTC, or any official thereof.
- Express mail entries** must include signature waiver permitting them to be left at the Show Secretary's address. Mail requiring signatures will be returned to sender. Faxed or e-mailed entries cannot be accepted. **No online entries will be taken for this trial.**
- Entries must be on the Official AKC Agility Entry Form for Agility Trial.** Entry forms without the AKC agreement, attached to the entry form, are NOT ACCEPTABLE and will be returned to the exhibitor. Unsigned, and incomplete entries are not acceptable and dog cannot be entered in the trial. (AKC Rule Ch 14, Sec 4)
- Illegible entries** will not be processed and will be returned to the exhibitor.
- Entry form changes**, additions or corrections must be received in writing prior to the February 10, 2021 closing date and time.

If you provide a valid, legible, unblocked email address, your entries will be acknowledged via email when received. To receive a confirmation by US mail, Please include a self-addressed, stamped envelope. Final confirmation and judging program will also be sent via email after the trial closes. If you do not provide an email address, your conformation letter and judging program will be mailed to the address provided on your entry form. If you have not received your confirmation five days before the trial, please contact the Trial Secretary.

Refunds

- No refund for duplicate entries.** Every effort will be made to find all duplicate entries; however, if an entry has been processed, no refund will be made.
- Owners are responsible** for errors in making out entry forms, whoever may make such errors, and no entry fee will be refunded in event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date.
- A dog withdrawn** from the trial after the event's closing date and time due to a change of judge will receive a refund specifically for any runs under that judge only.
- Entry fees shall not be refunded** in the event that the dog is absent, disqualified, excused by a Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee.
- No entry fee will be refunded** if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee. No entry fee will be refunded in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by the action of the Trial Committee.
- A refund of entry fees less \$20 per day** for injured/incapacitated dogs will be made if entrants provide an excuse from their vet on formal letterhead stating that the dog is unable to run. This excuse must be presented to the Trial Secretary no later than the day of the trial.

Dogs Eligible to Enter

- This trial is open** to all dogs fifteen (15) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number, or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds. Mixed breed dogs that have been listed with AKC Canine Partners may participate provided their listing number has been recorded on the entry form. Refer to Chapter 2 of the Registration and Discipline Rules for the listing of registerable breeds that may participate.
- Dogs with Purebred Alternative Listing (PAL), Indefinite Listing Privileges (ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number** must be spayed or neutered in order to compete. Wherever the word "dog" is used in these regulations, it includes both sexes.
- Dogs that are blind or deaf** shall not be eligible and neither are aggressive dogs or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. No dog shall compete if it is bandaged or taped in any way or has anything attached to it for medical purposes.
- Puppies under four months** of age are strictly prohibited from the trial grounds.
- Bitches in season** are not eligible to compete. Bitches in season are eligible for a full refund with veterinarian confirmation. This certificate must be presented to the Trial Secretary prior to the start of judging on the first day of the trial or cluster of trials. Refunds will be mailed.

Important Exhibitor Information

WCOTC is delighted to hold its February 2021 agility trials at B&D Creekside Activity Center. Unlike previous years, we have "New Normal" protocols that are incorporated into WCOTC COVID-19 Guidelines that all of us have to follow. We request everyone's help to have a safe and fun weekend.

By entering these trials, I have read and agree to abide by the WCOTC Covid-19 Guidelines which includes social distancing and wearing a mask at all times, including while running on the course, to ensure a safe environment for everyone. I will also fully cooperate with any county or state guidelines. Exhibitors not complying with these guidelines will be asked to leave and not issued a refund.

To the best of my knowledge, at the time of the trial if I have Covid-19 or its symptoms, I agree to refrain from attending these trials. I agree that I am attending these trials entirely at my own risk and assume all risk and full responsibility for my own health and safety.

I fully submit that WCOTC, its members, directors, officers and all persons connected or associated with WCOTC are in no way liable for any present or future COVID-19 infection incurred at any time by any person, in attendance or not in attendance, before, during or after these trials

Safety, Behavior and Liability

- It is expressly understood** that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create an unnecessary disturbance or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the trial committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made. The Westmoreland County Obedience Training Club and its agents, employees, etc., will assume no responsibilities for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children. The Westmoreland County Obedience Training Club reserves the right to decline entries for cause and may remove any dog on account of aggression. No one shall have any recourse or claim against the Westmoreland County Obedience Training Club or any official thereof.
- The safety of the dog is our primary concern.** By entering these trials, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.
- All Dogs** present at the site must be on leads or confined to crates or x-pens when not being judged, except when in the exercise area or designated warm-up area. No exceptions. A designated exercise area is provided.
- This club does not agree to arbitrate claims as set forth on the Official AKC Entry Form for this event.**

Notice to Exhibitors

- Dogs may arrive** any time prior to judging if the dog has a valid temporary or permanent jump height card. Otherwise, they must be available for measuring prior to the start of their class if a VMO or AKC Field Rep is available to measure dogs. All dogs not needed for further judging will be excused.
- Judges are not required** to wait for dogs. The Owner of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at ringside when it is to be judged. The Club has no responsibility for providing service through a public address system or stewards or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required.
- A limited amount of Catalogs** will be available at the trials at \$6.00 per catalog.
- WCOTC will not be responsible** for any lost or damaged items left at the show site.
- All exhibitors should obtain** a copy of the Regulations for Agility Trials by downloading them from the American Kennel Club website at <http://www.akc.org/rules/>.

Move-Ups

- If a dog earns an agility title** before this event, it can be moved up to the next level of competition. However, written notice MUST be given to Trial Secretary no later than 6:00 PM, Monday, February 22, 2021. Move-ups can be faxed to 412-373-3339 or emailed to poodles4me@verizon.net. No verbal move-ups will be accepted.
- Move-ups** will be accommodated from Saturday to Sunday. If a title is received on Saturday, then the dog can move up. Move-ups for Sunday will not be accepted at the trial if the dog is not entered on Saturday. Move-up forms must be given to the Trial Secretary no later than one half hour after the completion of the trial.

Ring, Obstacle and Warm-Up Information

- Obstacles will meet** the specifications for obstacles in the current edition of the AKC Regulations for Agility Trials. Refer to the Regulations for Agility Trials for current list of mandatory obstacles.
- All classes** will take place indoors on field turf surface. Each ring will be 100' x 90'.
- Handlers in all classes** are permitted to walk the course, without a dog, during a walk-through period held prior to the start of the class. The walk-through is restricted to handlers entered in that class only. Handlers with multiple dogs, at events with multiple rings may request to walk with a height group other than the one their dog is entered in if a conflict is imminent.
- A warm-up area**, consisting of a regulation agility jump, is provided for exhibitors. The warm-up area is to be used exclusively for warming up the dog and not for training or relieving of the dog.

Site Information

- ❑ **The B&D Creekside Activity Center** is air conditioned. All doors must be left closed. Exhibitor entrances are along the side of the building.
- ❑ **Crates may be left overnight**, however, WCOTC and the B&D Creekside Activity Center will not be responsible for any lost or damaged items left at the show site. A tarp, mat or plastic must be placed under crates, x-pens, chairs, and food/water bowls.
- ❑ **Crating Space is limited.** Exhibitors should consolidate their crating area or they might be asked to do so. **Ex-pens allowed for VERY large dogs or multiple dogs only.**
- ❑ **Food and beverages** may be available for purchase on the show site. There are various restaurants and fast food vendors within a very short driving distance.
- ❑ **Exhibitors are responsible** for cleaning up after their dog(s). Any exhibitor failing to do so may be excused without benefit of refund if the Trial Committee deems the exhibitor to be in violation of this requirement. Cleaning supplies and disposal sites will be available at various locations around the show grounds.
- ❑ **Grooming of dogs is not permitted** in the arena.

Class Changes Effective January 1, 2020

- Exhibitors may enter a mixture of both Regular and Preferred classes on the same trial day and/or during a trial weekend. The same dog may now be entered in Regular FAST and/or T2B to finish up those titles while also entered in Preferred Master STD/JWW to start working towards their PACH at the lower height. Any mixture of Regular and Preferred classes is allowed.
- If a dog qualifies in Regular Master Standard and Preferred Master JWW (or vice versa) on the same trial day, then NO Double Q shall be earned toward either the MACH or PACH title.
- Within the same Regular or Preferred classes, a dog may now be entered in multiple jump heights within the same trial day.
- A separate entry form must be submitted when the same dog is being entered in a mixture of Regular and Preferred and/or different jump heights within the same trial weekend thereby clearly indicating which class(es) and/or jump heights belong together for each trial day of the weekend.
- When calculating entry fees, treat multiple entry forms for the same dog as if only one form had been filled out. The 1st run entry fee is only paid once per day, per dog, even if that dog's runs have been submitted on multiple entry forms.

Entering For Exhibition Only (FEO)

- FEO will allow exhibitors to work with their dogs in a trial environment. FEO is only allowed in the Time 2 Beat and FAST classes. Participation in FEO is non-qualifying.
- FEO runs are treated as trial entries. The exhibitor must enter the class(es) (T2B and/or FAST) prior to the closing date, pay class entry fee(s) and enter in the desired jump height.
- Dogs may be entered in any jump height for FEO runs. If entered in an ineligible jump height, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show jump height changes are not allowed
- Dogs may be entered in any level of FAST (Novice, Open, Excellent, Master. If the dog is not eligible for the level entered, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show level changes are not allowed
- The exhibitor must declare FEO in the ring prior to leading out.
- Toys are allowed in the ring. - must be non-audible - may not leave the handler's hand - toys that roll freely cannot be used
- Food/treats are not allowed in the ring
- FEO should be utilized for the benefit of the dog and not as a punitive correction. Judges can stop a run at any time.

Fix and Go On (FNG)

- FNG allows exhibitors to immediately reattempt an obstacle at any time while on course when the dog's performance of an obstacle is not to their expectation. Using FNG will result in a non-qualifying score.

- ❑ Qualifying ribbons will be awarded to all dogs receiving a qualifying score in each titling class.
- ❑ Rosettes will be awarded to 1st through 4th place dogs in each jump height and in each class.
- ❑ New title rosettes will be awarded to all dog/handler teams finishing a title.
- ❑ A MACH/PACH rosette and bar will be awarded to the team finishing their Master Agility Championship and Preferred Master Agility Championship. An AGCH rosette will be awarded to the team finishing their Agility Grand Champion title.
- ❑ Exhibitors will receive a dog toy valued at \$1-\$3 dollars for each dog entered for the weekend.
- ❑ All rosettes and ribbons must be claimed at the trial, none will be mailed.

Height Divisions

The exhibitor is fully responsible for entering the dog in the correct class(es)/height divisions. All Heights are as measured at the withers. Dogs measuring into the 8" through 20" regular division may optionally enter the 24C division.

Dogs entered in Preferred classes, **must** jump at a height 4" lower than the minimum height they would be required to jump in the Regular class heights.

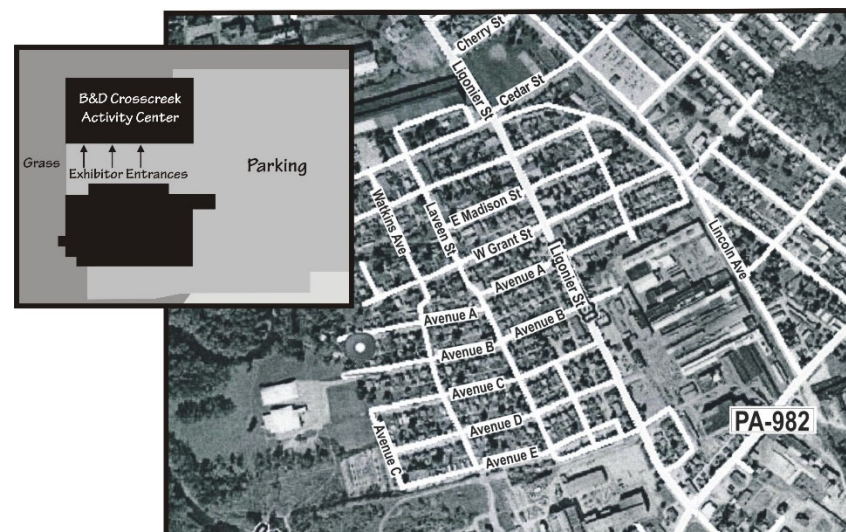

From the East: Take I-70/US 30 W. Continue to follow US-30 W. Merge onto PA-982 toward Bradenville (go 1.0 Miles). Turn LEFT onto LIGONIER ST. (*LIGONIER is just past DIANE St.*) (go 0.3 Miles). Turn LEFT onto AVENUE B. (*AVENUE B is just past AVENUE C*) (go 0.3 Miles). 501 AVENUE B is on the RIGHT. (*destination is just past WATKINS AVE.*) (go 0.01 Miles)

From the West: Take US-22 E. Turn RIGHT onto PA-981 (go 6.5 Miles). Turn Right onto PA-981/Industrial Blvd. Continue to follow PA-981 S (go 0.5 Miles). Turn LEFT onto LINCOLN AVE./PA-981. AKC Code of Sportsmanship

PREFACE: The sport of purebred dog competitive events dates prior to 1884, the year of AKC's birth. Shared values of those involved in the sport include principles of sportsmanship. They are practiced in all sectors of our sport: conformation, performance and companion. Many believe that these principles of sportsmanship are the prime reason why our sport has thrived for over one hundred years. With the belief that it is useful to periodically articulate the fundamentals of our sport, this code is presented.

- Sportsmen respect the history, traditions and integrity of the sport of purebred dogs.
- Sportsmen commit themselves to values of fair play, honesty, courtesy, and vigorous competition, as well as winning and losing with grace.
- Sportsmen refuse to compromise their commitment and obligation to the sport of purebred dogs by injecting personal advantage or consideration into their decisions or behavior.
- The sportsman judge judges only on the merits of the dogs and considers no other factors.
- The sportsman judge or exhibitor accepts constructive criticism.
- The sportsman exhibitor declines to enter or exhibit under a judge where it might reasonably appear that the judge's placements could be based on something other than the merits of the dogs.
- The sportsman exhibitor refuses to compromise the impartiality of a judge.
- The sportsman respects the AKC bylaws, rules, regulations and policies governing the sport of purebred dogs.
- Sportsmen find that vigorous competition and civility are not inconsistent and are able to appreciate the merit of their competition and the effort of competitors.
- Sportsmen welcome, encourage and support newcomers to the sport.
- Sportsmen will deal fairly with all those who trade with them.
- Sportsmen are willing to share honest and open appraisals of both the strengths and weaknesses of their breeding stock.
- Sportsmen spurn any opportunity to take personal advantage of positions offered or bestowed upon them.
- Sportsmen always consider as paramount the welfare of their dog.
- Sportsmen refuse to embarrass the sport, the American Kennel Club, or themselves while taking part in the sport.

WCOTC February 2021 Covid-19 Guidelines

WCOTC is delighted to hold its February 2021 agility trials at B&D Creekside Activity Center in Latrobe PA. Unlike previous years, we have "New Normal" protocols that are incorporated into WCOTC COVID-19 Guidelines that all of us have to follow. We hope to have a safe and fun agility weekend and know that we can count on you to make sure the guidelines are followed to safeguard the safety of everyone attending our trials.

Please do NOT attend this trial: (a) if you were exposed to Covid-19 within 10 days preceding the trial and do not have a confirmed negative result from testing done after the exposure. (b) if you have COVID-19 or it's symptoms at the time of the trial. (c) if you feel ill in any way during the trials, please contact the Trial Secretary if you wish to request a full refund for any runs not yet completed. At the time of the trial please go to: <https://www.pa.gov/guides/responding-to-covid-19/#Travel> to see a guide that will be kept up to date as Pennsylvania resources and information change.

The following guidelines are based on AKC Best Practices for the Well-Being of Dog Sport Participants, the State of Pennsylvania and CDC guidelines. National, State, and Local COVID-19 requirements and recommendations are unfolding as time goes on so these Protocols may be updated at any time. Any changes will be communicated as soon as possible before the trial weekend. If you can't comply with any of the changes, please contact the Trial Secretary prior to the trial to withdraw and request a re-fund.

These guidelines also apply to anyone attending with you to assist at the trials and may be asked to leave if not complying.

- 1. MASKS:** An appropriate face covering MUST always be worn in the building, including WHILE RUNNING. Masks must be worn correctly, covering both nose and mouth at all times. No exceptions/exemptions. Bring your own face mask. You do not need to wear a mask when outside the building as long as you maintain social distancing
- 2. GLOVES:** Bring disposable gloves or some type of glove if you want to wear them at any time during the trials.
- 3. CHAIRS:** Bring your own chairs. B & D chairs will not be available for general use. The normal bleachers are folded and put away. They will not be in use.
- 4. FOOD:** Please do not bring food. It will be available in the on-site restaurant, Dexterz. ***Per the AKC guidelines for Covid-19 you may NOT bring in shared food, potlucks, and NO MACH CAKES. ***
- 5. WASH HANDS:** Practice personal hygiene frequently and thoroughly. Use hand sanitizers positioned throughout the building and try to bring your own. Avoid touching dogs that are not your responsibility. We will clean commonly touched surfaces regularly throughout the trial and again at the end of the day.
- 6. SANITIZATION:** All equipment and surfaces have been thoroughly cleaned and sanitized. Please bring your own cleaning and sanitizing supplies. There will be a limited amount available at the trial. REMOVE ALL DISHES AND WATER BOWLS BEFORE LEAVING EACH DAY!!
- 7. ONE-WAY DOORS-TRAFFIC FLOW:** Doors will be CLEARLY marked "Enter" and "Exit" with large signs. Please respect social distancing when entering and exiting the building and navigating through the building.
- 8. COURSE BUILDERS/RING CREW WORKERS:** Anyone setting up rings and changing bar heights **can** wear gloves, use sanitizing wipes, and/or hand sanitizer before and after setting up and while working in the ring. (Gloves, wipes, and hand sanitizer provided on scribe table).
- 9. TIMER/SCRIBE/SCORE RUNNER:** The Scribe will be the only person handling the scribe sheets. The Scribe will pick up a basket of sheets with a pen from the Secretary. Sheets will be checked by the scribe against the running order prior to the class. All completed scribe sheets will be placed in the basket for the score runner, who will dump them in a basket on the secretary scoring table. Social distancing will apply between scribe and timer. At end of the class, the timer will wipe down the timer box and score runner will return the last sheets in the basket with the pen to the secretary score table.
- 10. CHECK IN BOARDS/GATE STEWARD:** Verbally check in with the Worker with the run order boards at the table. This person will check your name off. The gate steward will move the check in board to the ring and continue to check in individuals who haven't already checked in. You may **NOT** touch the board or the pen used by the Worker or the Gate Steward. Please remember to maintain a 6 ft. distance from these workers.
- 11. LEASHES/LEASH RUNNER:** We encourage exhibitors to tuck their leash into a pocket or wear it securely on their person (i.e. clip it like a belt around your waist so no part is hanging) when running the course. If you opt to drop your leash, the leash runner may wear gloves and pick the leash up with a paper towel to transport it to the exit location.
- 12. ENTERING AND EXITING RING:** The gate tops will be wiped off after each run. Hand sanitizer will be available after your run.
- 13. COURSE MAPS, BRIEFINGS, RUN ORDERS, AND RESULTS:** Items will be posted in several areas to help with social distancing. You may snap camera/phone pictures of the maps and results as paper handouts will NOT be available. ONLINE MAPS, BRIEFINGS, and RUN ORDERS, will be posted by the Trial Secretary each evening for the next day, hopefully between 7 and 9 PM. The URL will be provided in the Judging Program.
- 14. WALK THROUGHS/BRIEFINGS:** Per AKC guidelines, walkthroughs will be limited to 25 people at most. Additional walk throughs will be added as needed to keep numbers and crowding down. We encourage everyone to be mindful of others, take turns, and maintain personal distance. There will be NO obsessive walk throughs and NO Mas/Ex briefings.
- 15. RIBBONS, TOYS, AND AWARDS:** There will be no self-serve ribbons. Exhibitors must line up six feet apart to pick up ribbons and stickers. There will be a volunteer in this area to place your sticker on the Q ribbon (or give the sticker to you to put in your book if you prefer) and give you any ribbons you are to be awarded. *(So sorry, but you cannot take a ribbon for pictures and then return it.)* **TOYS:** Every dog entered in the trial will receive one complimentary gift for the weekend as stated in the premium. Please do not dig through the bins when selecting the items you want. Please pick the item you want for your dog and touch that one item only...no exchanges. Toys will not be given for placements. The only ribbons/bars on display will be the MACH/PACH ribbons/bars, which you may view, but please do not touch.
- 16. MEASURING of DOGS:** If there are no VMOs in attendance, then no dogs will be measured. If a VMO is present and willing to measure dogs, then entered dogs may be able to get a measurement if they follow the VMO's directions.

17. **CRATING:** Indoor crating has not been a problem during the last few trials. But crating in the building **may be limited** based on government limits and distancing guidelines in effect. The limits are under consideration and if changed by the Pennsylvania governor, we may need to restrict the number of people in the building at any one time. Six-foot social distancing will apply inside and outside for the entire weekend (including 6' spacing between "household crating groups"). You may not always be able to sit with your dog if it is crated in the building. Please be aware that every night the equipment in the ring area will be misted with a disinfectant of water and bleach. This will be done with a handheld misting machine that will be kept pointed away from the crating area. It is your responsibility to decide whether to leave your crates and water bowls in the building overnight!
18. **RESERVED PARKING for CAR CRATING:** A limited number of parking spaces close to doors will be reserved ONLY for people willing to crate from their cars for the weekend and are available on a first-reserved basis. Please contact Sandy Crighton no later than Tuesday evening, February 23rd at crighton673@comcat.net! Include cell #, color and make of car, and license plate number in your email. Please be sure to take proper safety precautions with your dogs as long as they are crated in your vehicle. YOUR DOGS' SAFETY COMES FIRST!!
19. **TENT/EZ-Up OUTDOOR CRATING:** If weather permits, "tent crating" will be allowed **anywhere** on the grass, but not in the immediate potty area at the end of the building and not in the parking lots or concrete pad next to the equipment garage door! (Please not too close to the garage doors!) They may be left overnight at your own risk – neither B&D nor WCOTC will be responsible for theft or damage due to weather.
20. **BUILDING OCCUPANCY CONTROL:** Only workers and exhibitors entered in the trial should be in the building. We encourage you to leave additional family and friends at home unless necessary to help you during the trials. We need to keep building numbers at a minimum to stay within state guidelines.
21. **COMPLETED RUNS:** Once your runs are over for the day, and if you are not scheduled to work, please take your dog/dogs and exit the building. This practice will help keep our numbers in a manageable range.
22. **VOLUNTEERS:** We are all in this together. We look forward to returning to this agility sport, and hope you will continue to "work together" and help our trial run smoothly. We **NEED** and **WELCOME** your help and thank everyone who will volunteer to assist us!
