ISC CLASS INFORMATION:

Entry requirements for international sweepstakes classes (ISC):

Purpose: The international sweepstakes class (ISC) is a non-regular class providing the dog and handler an opportunity to demonstrate their advanced training and handling skills on various international style Standard and Jumpers With Weaves courses. The rules for This class are generally based on international rules. The variety in international agility Course designs is very diverse, so handlers should be prepared to meet the "Challenge Of The Day" when competing in the ISC class. The total challenge level may be easier, more difficult, or simply different from what is currently allowed in excellent / master Class. Complete rules for the ISC are available from the AKC website (<http://www.akc.org>).

Eligibility: ISC classes are open to dogs that are eligible to compete in AKC agility trials. There is no Preferred Option for ISC; dogs may enter at their preferred jump height; however they will be scored against the regular division dogs jumping the same jump height.

Jump Heights: DOGS MAY BE ENTERED IN THEIR REGULAR JUMP HEIGHTS, however, only those dogs running in the 12", 16", 20" and 24" class that meet the FCI/ISC measuring cutoff (different than regular AKC cutoffs) may use their clean run toward the required qualification toward entering WTT or EOTT. Please see the EO/AWC Tryout Rules for further details.

The FCI/ISC height cutoffs are as follows:

- 12" - Small team – shoulder height = 13 3/4" or less (35 cm is the FCI cutoff)
- 16" - Medium team – shoulder height = 16 7/8" or less (43 cm is the FCI cutoff)
- 20" - Intermediate team – shoulder height = 18 7/8" or less (48 cm is the FCI cutoff)
- 24" - Large team – shoulder height = greater than 18 7/8" (greater than 48 cm)

Eligible dogs may be entered in **any level of ISC** (Grade 1, 2, or 3). At present, there are no eligibility requirements for any level of ISC and any dog that is eligible according to the above information may run any level. Day of show level changes are not allowed.

RIBBONS, AWARDS, AND PRIZES

Ribbons will be awarded in each jump height division in each class as follows:

First Place.....Rose
 Second Place.....Brown
 Third Place.....Light Green
 Fourth Place.....Gray
 Clear Round/Qualifying Run.....Dark Green

Illegible entries will not be processed and will be returned to the exhibitor. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry and the Trial Secretary will add a \$30.00 collection fee to the amount of each returned check.

ELIGIBILITY AND HEIGHT DIVISIONS

Dogs Eligible to Enter

This trial is open to all dogs (15) months or age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or are register able breeds that have obtained an AKC, ILP or PAL number. *Bitches in season are allowed to compete in panties.* Aggressive, blind, or deaf dogs or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance are ineligible to participate. Mixed breed dogs that have been listed with AKC Canine Partners may participate provided their listing number has been recorded on the entry Form.

Jump Height Information

All dogs without height cards will have to be measured by the judge of record, except 24"/24C" dogs. If a VMO or an AKC Representative is available, all dogs without height cards, including 24"/24C" dogs, will need to be measured. When filling out the entry form, there is a new section at the top of the form for exhibitors to designate whether your dog has a valid jump height card or if your dog needs to be measured. Please check the appropriate box so that the Trial Secretary knows whether to include your dogs on the *Dogs To Be Measured List*. All height divisions will be offered. At the handler's option, dogs may be entered in a higher jump height class, except in preferred classes, where dogs must be entered in their measured height division. Dogs running in a lower height division than they are eligible for will be eliminated. The exhibitor is fully responsible for entering the dog in the correct class(es)/height divisions.

WAIT LIST INFORMATION

AAKA, Inc is offering a wait list to fill openings created by withdrawn entries after the trial's closing date/time. A maximum of 20 entries will be placed on the club's wait list. All entries, including wait-listed entries, must be received by the Trial Secretary prior to **June 6, 2026** at 6 pm. Any entries withdrawn after **June 6, 2026** at 6 p.m. will be replaced by a wait listed entry if any are available. If a withdrawn entry is replaced by a wait-listed entry, a full refund will be issued for the withdrawn entry. Any wait-listed entry that does not move off the wait list into the trial by **June 6, 2026** at noon will receive a full refund.

ENTERING FOR EXHIBITION ONLY (FEO)

FEO allows exhibitors to work with their dogs in a trial environment. Because this is an ISC Only Event, FEO is available for every ISC run. Participation in FEO is non-qualifying.

- For Exhibition Only may be offered at the option of the host club. FEO will allow exhibitors to work with their dogs in a trial environment.
- FEO runs are treated as trial entries. The exhibitor must enter the class(es) prior to the closing date, pay class entry fee(s) and the Trial Secretary must record the entry in the Trial Catalog as part of the results for that class. FEO does not need to be noted on the entry form; the handler will declare the day of the show.
- Dogs may be entered in any jump height for FEO runs. If entered in an ineligible jump height, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show jump height changes are not allowed.
- The exhibitor must declare FEO in the ring prior to leading out to the scribe and the judge.
- Course time is 45 seconds.

COURSE WALK-THROUGHS * WARM-UP INFORMATION * RINGSIDE

Handlers in all classes are permitted to walk the course, without a dog, during a walk-through period held prior to the start of the class. The walk-through is restricted to handlers entered in that class only.

A warm-up area, consisting of a regulation agility jump, may be provided for exhibitors. The warm-up area is to be used exclusively for warming up the dog and not for training or relieving of the dog.

Judges are not required to wait for dogs. The Owner of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at ringside when it is to be judged. The Club has no responsibility for providing service through a public address system or stewards or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required.

OBSTACLES AND RING CONDITIONS

Obstacles will meet the specifications for obstacles in the current edition of the Regulations for Agility Trials. All classes will take place inside a climate-controlled building on a field turf surface. Ring size will be 135' x 120'.

ADDITIONAL SITE INFORMATION

Crating space will be available on a limited basis. The trial site requires a tarp to be placed on the floor underneath your crates. Crates may be left overnight; however, the **AAKA, Inc** and the

B & D Creekside Activity Center will not be responsible for any lost or damaged items left at the show site.

A full service food restaurant is available on the site. There are various restaurants and fast-food vendors within a very short driving distance.

Overnight parking will be allowed at the trial site. Electrical hook-ups for motor homes or campers are available.

Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dog(s). Any exhibitor failing to do so may be excused without benefit of refund if the Trial Committee deems the exhibitor to be in

violation of this requirement. Cleaning supplies and disposal sites will be available at various locations around the show grounds.

SAFETY, BEHAVIOR and LIABILITY

The safety of the dog is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely. It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create an unnecessary disturbance or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the trial committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made. AAKA and its agents, employees, etc., assume no responsibilities for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children. AAKA reserves the right to decline entries for cause and may remove any dog on account of aggression. No one shall have any recourse or claim against AAKA or any official thereof. All dogs must be on leash at all times when on trial grounds except when in the designated warm-up area or competing on the course. Emailed entry changes are not official until the exhibitor has received email confirmation back from the Trial Secretary.

REFUNDS

No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee. No entry fee will be refunded in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by the action of the Trial Committee.

The club will refund entry fees less \$10 per day of the entry fee paid for Bitches in Season unable to compete. A veterinarian certificate must be presented to the Trial Secretary prior to the start of judging on the first day of the trial.

This club agrees to arbitrate claims as set forth on the Official AKC Entry Form for this event.

Instructions

Handlers whose dogs measure into the 8" through 20" regular jump height divisions may opt to enter in a higher or 24-choice height division for all Regular titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs who measure into the 24" regular jump height division may not enter 24-choice. Dogs entered in the Preferred classes must compete at the required jump height and may not compete in a jump height division higher or lower than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial or back-to-back trials only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Dogs listed in the AKC Canine Partners Program may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.

Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler Number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 233-9767. If the Junior Handler is not the owner of the dog identified on the face of this form, what is the relationship of the Junior Handler to the Owner?
