MAYOR'S REPORT

1. I have a bid from our electrician for a new control panel at Rea Clinic lift station. The electrical panel needs to be updated.

The lift station was installed in the late seventies. Ken Hall Electric bid \$4,102.00.

2. I was asked by (LIUNA) Laborer's International Union to pass a resolution of support. This resolution is for the apprenticeship program to train individuals to be journeyman.

This program has been successful over the years in training labors in the upcoming technologies.

3. I have signed a contract with CK Power to service our civic center generator. Total cost is \$1,050.00 per two inspections a year.

4. Dan Dowling bid out our health insurance and Blue Cross/ Blue Shield was the cheapest. Our old rate was \$11,592.39 and new rate \$12,709.40. Our new policy has the same coverage except \$5.00 more per doctor visit.



We have received bids on our municipal aggregation agreement for next year, June of 2020 to June 2022. The bid came in 30% less than our old bid and 3% under Ameren. The new rate will be 4.584 per kwh. This rate will be effective June 20, 2020. All indication are Ameren rates will increase next year. Homefield was low bidder.
