- 1) Discussion on new structure to be built on Jaycess site. Donnie Miklos and I are working on the replacement building.
- 2) Approve a quote from "Target Solutions" for a teaching and training program for the fire department. This program will fulfill OSHA, Illinois Department of Labor, National Protection of Labor, National Fire Protection Association (NFPA) and the Illinois State Fire Marshal Office

The cost is annual maintenance fee \$ 395.00 Annual Membership 17 employees \$1,5130.00 Total \$1,908.00

Optional station and truck inventory per year \$799.00

- 3) Illinois Municipal League (77,474.96) insurance payment for 2020. NOTE: Our insurance has NOT increased since last year.
- 4) We have already approved work on the fire Dept generator. Due to an increase, we should reapprove bid from Loyd electric \$4,300.00 automatic set.
- 5) I have ordered several new street signs from Sa-So. We have several signs missing or run over

- 7) I had a meeting with our engineer on the South Snider Street project. After reviewing the cost, we have reduced the estimated cost to \$218,300.00. Our original estimate was \$266,810.00. The council will have to vote so the project can be released for bids.
