



CURBSIDE CLEANUP GUIDELINES (HOUSEHOLD ITEMS ONLY)

Items Accepted During Curbside Cleanup:

- **All items, with the exception of furniture, must be bagged:**
 - Bags cannot exceed 35 lbs. each
 - **Limit of 10 bags** per household
- Furniture
 - Couches, chairs, dressers, tables, mattress sets, desks, headboards, etc.
 - **Limit of 200 lbs.** per household
- Carpet: Must be cut into sections, rolled up and tied with string/twine:
 - Bundles should not be longer than 4ft in length
 - Bundles should not exceed 35 lbs. each
 - **Limit of 10 bundles** per household
- Basketball poles: NOTE: These must be broken down/cut into **4ft. sections**



Items Not Accepted During Curbside Cleanup:

- Construction debris/home remodel or demolition debris of any kind:
 - Shingles, drywall, vinyl siding, molding/trim, fencing, kitchen cabinets, etc.
- Appliances (refrigerators, freezers, washers, dryers, dishwashers, stoves)
- Air Conditioners
- Water Heaters
- Tires
- Any liquid form of lead/oil based paint or varnish
- Yard waste
- Fluorescent light bulbs
- Electronic Waste – due to IL state law, electronics cannot be disposed of in landfills and therefore cannot be placed at the curb for pickup. This includes televisions, computer monitors/accessories, and DVD/VCR players.
