MAYOR'S REPORT

- The city has received their insurance invoice for 2025. The cost to insure the city is \$93,823.00.
 Payment has been made to Risk Management. We saved 1% by paying early.
- 2. The Homecoming Committee is working on cost estimates to cover the boccie courts. The estimate from Coal Belt Sales is \$19,598.25.
- 3. Jeremy Cobin has a tree half on his property and half on the city alley. Four years ago the city told Mr. Cobin they will assume 50% responsibility. The oak tree is probably over 80 years old.
- 4. I applied for a D.R.A. (Delta Regional Authority) grant to revitalize our sewage lagoon system in May. I was invited October 10th to Carbondale airport to a D.R.A. announcement. Christopher was awarded \$509,000.00 to revitalize our sewage system. This grant was put together by our engineers and submitted by Greater Egypt. There were only three entities in southern Illinois to receive this grant award.
- 5. I am working on our annual tax levy.
