"We have the most video gaming terminals than any other state. Most of them are in our rural communities," Garate said. "It's just like any other substance use disorder. Impact of 2020 Suspensions Of Video Gaming

Eric Noggle, a senior revenue analyst with the State's Commission on Government Forecasting and Accountability, said video gambling revenue has steadily gone up year by year, until the governor restricted video gaming due to the pandemic. "He [Pritzker] suspended operations between March 16th and June 30th of 2020. During that time, things abruptly changed, where we weren't getting revenues in at all." **When pandemic restrictions were eased,** Noggle said **there was an immediate resurgence in gambling.** <u>Read more</u>

Accel Entertainment--Largest video gambling operator

By February 5, all regions returned to normal hours of gaming operations with limited indoor dining. As reported in the IGB data, **Accel generated more**

than \$48 million of gaming revenue in February, the best month in our history despite extreme temperatures, multiple snowstorms and only being 28 days long. Revenue at locations opened in both February 2020 and February 2021 was up almost 20%, mostly driven by the higher bet limit software and the additional 6 video gambling machines. On December 30, 2020, Accel acquired American Video Gaming, a Northern Illinois operator for \$30 million. <u>Read more</u>
