Chicago-based marijuana giant part of federal pay-to-play investigation

A Chicago-based marijuana cultivator and dispenser--Green Thumb -Industries--that has rapidly grown into one of the nation's biggest pot firms is under federal investigation for possible pay-to-play violations during its push for coveted state licenses, sources said.

State records show that during its rise, GTI's executives and affiliates have spread cash to a number of politicians as well as a political action committee that were instrumental in the marijuana legalization effort. The company also hired a succession of lobbyists and consultants with deep ties to then-House Speaker Michael Madigan, records show. Read more.

Legalized Pot Tied to Rise in Young Men's Suicide Attempts

States that make marijuana a readily available retail item might see an increase in self-harm among younger men, a new study suggests.

Researchers found a correlation between U.S. states' shifting marijuana policies and rates of self-harm among men younger than 40 Those rates -- which include suicide attempts and non-suicidal behaviors like cutting -- increased in states that legalized, and in some cases "commercialized," recreational marijuana. Opinion: Recreational marijuana is bad for public health and safety

Words like "recreational" sound safe, yet cannabis use increases the risk of depression, suicide, psychosis, cognitive impairment and worsened academic performance in youths. Since the state of Washington legalized the recreational use of marijuana, studies have shown that 23% of youths who committed suicide had marijuana in their systems — up from 14%. Read
