Chicago-based marijuana giant part of federal pay-to-play investigation

Investigators have been scrutinizing campaign donations and other steps Green Thumb Industries look as it sought to secure growing and distribution licenses in Illinois and several other states, sources told the Chicago Tribune.

In addition to lobbyists, the company brought some well-known Chicago names into the fold. In 2014, GTI made headlines by hiring former Chicago police Superintendent Terry Hillard and Terry Gainer, a former Chicago cop, Illinois State police director and head of the U.S. Capitol Police in Washington, D.C., to lead its security team.

Meanwhile, GTI and its affiliate companies have donated to the campaigns of a number of Illinois politicians and also gave tens of thousands of dollars to a pro-cannabis organization, which in turn infused cash into local and state legislative contests, state campaign records show. Read more

Church leaders Oppose Sesser cannabis lounge

The Sesser-Valier Ministerial Alliance submitted a letter to the City Council, saying the coming Luna Lounge will have a negative impact on the community. Eight area pastors signed the letter and delivered it to Sesser City Council, and what they're looking for is additional oversight on a new type of business coming to their community.

Efforts to unionize Illinois' cannabis workers

Efforts are underway across the state to unionize around 16,000 workers in Illinois' legal cannabis industry.

The UFCW has joined with the Service Employees International Union to organize jobs at cultivation centers, craft growers, infusers, dispensing and lab testing organizations. 
