Springfield casino license resolution shelved. Is a casino without video gaming possible?

The Springfield Committee of the Whole Tuesday tabled a resolution that the city be included for consideration of receiving a casino license, but it may at least have the ear of a local membership group of bars and restaurants.

The unique look of a proposed downtown casino — with table games like blackjack and craps and roulette and sports betting, but minus video gaming — could be an appearement to Springfield businesses where video gaming is prolific.

According to the <u>Commission on Government Forecasting</u> <u>and Accountability</u>, Springfield operates 757 terminals that brought in nearly \$50 million this past fiscal year.

The <u>Central Illinois Licensed Beverage Association</u>
(CILBA) voted unanimously to oppose the casino ordinance and also oppose any future resolutions requesting consideration for
