Underage Gambling Alert - September 30, 2022



Mount Airy hit with \$260,825 in underage Gambling, renewal issue fines

Mount Airy Casino Resort is facing over a quarter-million dollars in fines, the bulk of which are penalties for underage gambling, the Pennsylvania Gaming Control Board announced Wednesday. According to a release from the PGCB, the agency issued three consent agreements Wednesday totaling \$280,825 in fines against two gaming operators, \$260,825 of which were directed at Mount Airy #1 LLC, the operator of the Mount Pocono casino resort.

The larger fine of \$160,000 against Mount Airy focused on three instances in which individuals under the legal gambling age of 21 gained access to the casino floor and gambled: a 18-year-old male who gambled at two slot machines; an 11-year-old female who gambled at 10 slot machines while both parents were present with her and cashed two vouchers; and two 13-year-old females who gambled at slot machines with their mother.
