

## CHARITY SPOTLIGHT – LOVING ALL PEOPLES

Q: Tell us a little bit about your org and mission?

A: We are an organization that loves, serves, and meets the needs of all people, without discrimination. Currently we are working with new arriving immigrants and refugees by helping them with practical needs.

For the past 20 years, we have devoted our lives to loving, helping, and reaching all people, regardless of nationality, race, lifestyle, economic level, or religious beliefs. This has included, immigrants refugees, asylum seekers, lower-income communities, addicts, those stuck in the sex industry (including sex trafficking victims), the HIV community, and also loving and reaching out to the LGBT communities.

Q What were the key projects of 2021 and how do you think the funds from PIN helped?

A: 2021 saw a surge of refugees in Dallas and our organization was working tirelessly to give a feeling of home for a group of families. We pooled in all our resources and funds to support families arriving in Dallas. The funds from PIN helped to support the daily needs of two new arriving Afghan families.

3. Your org was one of the recipients of PIN grants last year. How did you put the funds to use? Can you share the breakdown of funds utilization? Also, please share any pics of the projects supported by the funding from PIN Grants.

A: The funds from PIN were put to use immediately. We were able to use the funds to help two Afghan families with groceries, clothes, and some household items. We try not to take pictures of families.

Q What is your org's focus/goals for 2022?

A: We are in the process of buying or leasing a building for a community center where we can better help new arriving immigrants.

Q. If there was one thing you need to scale your org to the next level, what would it be ?

A: We need funds to get a building so we can start a food pantry, have storage for donations, and run other programs.
