Step 1: Choose Your Product Type

Pick a digital product that fits your skills and your audience's needs:

Pick a digital product that solves a real problem or adds value:

- eBooks & Mini-Guides Teach something specific
- Templates Canva, Notion, Excel, or Docs
- Digital Planners or Printables Journals, budget sheets, calendars
- Courses or Workshops Pre-recorded lessons or PDFs
- Creative Assets Stock photos, digital art, music
- Start small. Even a 10-page guide or 1-page template can make money.

Ask yourself: What are 5 things I like, and what are 5 things I can do?

Use this in ChatGPT to spark your first idea:

"Based on the 5 skills (write it) and the 5 things I like (write it) give me 5 profitable digital products that solve a problem.

"Give me 5 niche ideas for a digital product based on [your passion/skill]."

Step 2: Identify Your Niche & Problem to Solve

Before you create, ask: "What's a quick win I can give someone?" Examples:

- A business template for content planning
- A 30-day meal plan for busy moms
- A daily mindset journal for goal-setters
- Clarity = Sales. Focus your product on one purpose.

Step 3: Create It Using Free Tools

- Canva for ebooks, planners, and templates
- ChatGPT for writing, research, outlines
- Google Docs/Slides for workbooks, checklists
- Notion for digital planners or business templates

Step 4: Package It Professionally

- Make your product easy to use, attractive, and valuable. Include:
- A clear title or cover page
- Instructions on how to use it
- Clean layout and consistent fonts
- Bonus pages, if possible (checklists, quick tips)

First impressions matter. Keep it simple but sharp.

Step 5: Upload & Sell

Upload and sell on beginner-friendly platforms:

- Gumroad Easiest for digital products
- Stan Store Great for creators and link-in-bio stores
- Payhip No monthly fees, automatic delivery
- Etsy Best for planners, templates, and printables
- Set a fair price: \$7–\$27 is a great start for simple products.

Step 6: Promote It Online

Now get the word out!

- Share product previews on Instagram or TikTok
- Use Pinterest to drive traffic to your product
- Build an email list with a freebie related to your product
- Talk about the benefit, not just the features
 - People buy solutions, not files.

Bonus Tip: Start With a Freebie

Create a quick freebie like a checklist or mini-template.
Use it to collect emails, build trust, and upsell your full product.
