2020-2022.

A problem-solving team built to directly reduce emissions, create soil, create innovative collaborations and help the community.



The Q Collective convenes a team of 5: farmers, entrepreneurs, and advocates. The team joins the Gigatonne Challenge.

The team meets it's first goals, eliminating 15 tons of emissions. They work with local landscaping businesses and composters to turn cardboard into soil.

Along with 6 other teams from Kenya, India, and other regions, the team co-develops the Gigatonne Protocol.

The team collects over 40 tons of waste, destined for landfills, and converts it into soil. It also distributes local produce and service fees to 100+ local families.
