_____ That if I am installing any hard surface flooring, such as tile, natural stone, hardwood floor, laminate, or ceramic flooring, I will install a underlayment that has a minimum Sound Transmission Class of 56 as measured by ASTM (formerly known as American Society for Testing and Materials) in pamphlet AS 1276-1979. Possible products are Soundguard HD LVT, Proflex MSC 90, or AcoustiCork CRC950.

_____ That if I am replacing a garage door, the door will be hurricane rated. I will also consider installing a belt driven, nylon rollers, and a torsion spring in order to have a quieter operating garage door.

I, the undersigned unit owner(s), accept the responsibility for any structural or water damage resulting from work done at my unit. Upon resale, the new owner(s) becomes responsible for same as stated in the restrictive covenant.

IMPORTANT NOTICE

REGARDING HARD SURFACE FLOORING UNDERLAYMENT

Dear Waterfront in Naples Homeowner,

The Waterfront in Naples Board of Directors has done **considerable** research on the various underlayment flooring products on the market. Due to the manner of construction of our condominiums air space between upper floor slab and lower unit ceilings necessitate products that meet a minimum **Sound Transmission Class** of 56 or greater as measured by the **ASTM** (formerly known as American Society for Testing and Materials) in pamphlet AS 1276-1979.

Various products on the market are Soundguard HD LVT, Proflex MSC 90, or AcoustiCORK CRC950. Therefore the Board of Directors requires that you install a product that meets the above requirement of minimum STC 56 . In addition, once the underlayment has been installed, an inspection of material installed maybe required.

Please be advised that if a inadequate sound barrier (a product below the STC 56) is installed, you may be required to remove your installed flooring to resolve impact and foot traffic noise problems created as a result of poor sound control.

The manufactures' specifications for all underlay products must be submitted with your *Modification Application*.
