



About The Indie Author Project




ABOUT ELLEN L. EKSTRÖM

Ellen L. Ekström is a native of the San Francisco Bay Area and was educated locally. She received a bachelor's degree in theological studies with a concentration in Christian Mythos, also known as church history, and a sub-specialty in Christian Social Ethics. She took honors for both. Ordained to the vocational diaconate in 2002, she is a clergywoman in the Episcopal Church and is retired from parish ministry but still active in social justice issues and pastoral care. In 2024, she was inducted into Marquis Publishing's *Who's Who in America* for her literary work and service in the vocational diaconate.

Ellen has been fascinated by all things medieval since childhood. She is now studying Late Anglo-Saxon England in preparation for two forthcoming novels, Swannsaeld and The Sometime Queen-A Cheshire Tale, and the Fourth Crusade for George of Grasmere: The Ascalon Saga, the origin story of George Ascalon, a prequel to Armor of Light and Ascalon. Her preferred genres are fantasy/historical: her first novel, The Legacy, a tale of fourteenth-century Florence and Tuscany, was followed by her retelling of the St. George and the Dragon legend, Armor of Light, followed by St. Edmund Wood, a story of Victorian England—Ms. Ekström's homage to Thomas Hardy and the Brontë sisters—and the sequel to Armor of Light, Ascalon. She recently completed and released George of Grasmere: Part One-The Oath and the Twentieth Anniversary Edition of The Legacy. Occasionally she delves into matters of the modern heart, as evidenced by her novels set in the Twentieth Century: Tallis' Third Tune and Scarborough, which tell the same story of heartbreak and love from various points of view, and What She Wished For... a Cautionary Tale, a story about what can go wrong when you meet the right person. Just as a painter has many subjects to bring to a canvas, Ellen believes that there are many stories to tell, and to limit oneself to a niche isn't the way she lives or thinks.






